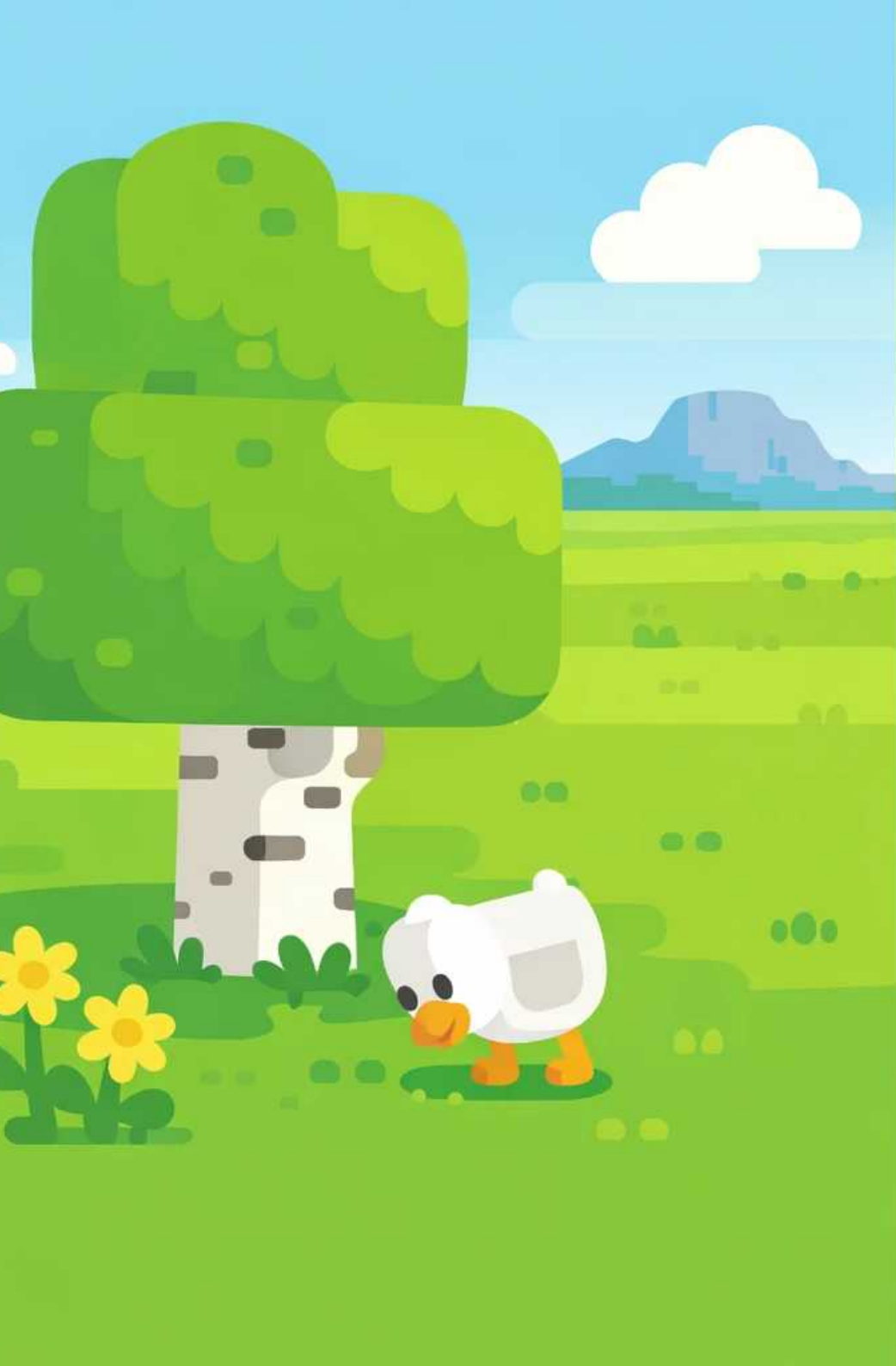




A Day on the Plains

The plains hold many animals. A pig sniffs along the trail, and a cow stays in the shade. Both may find a snack in the grass.



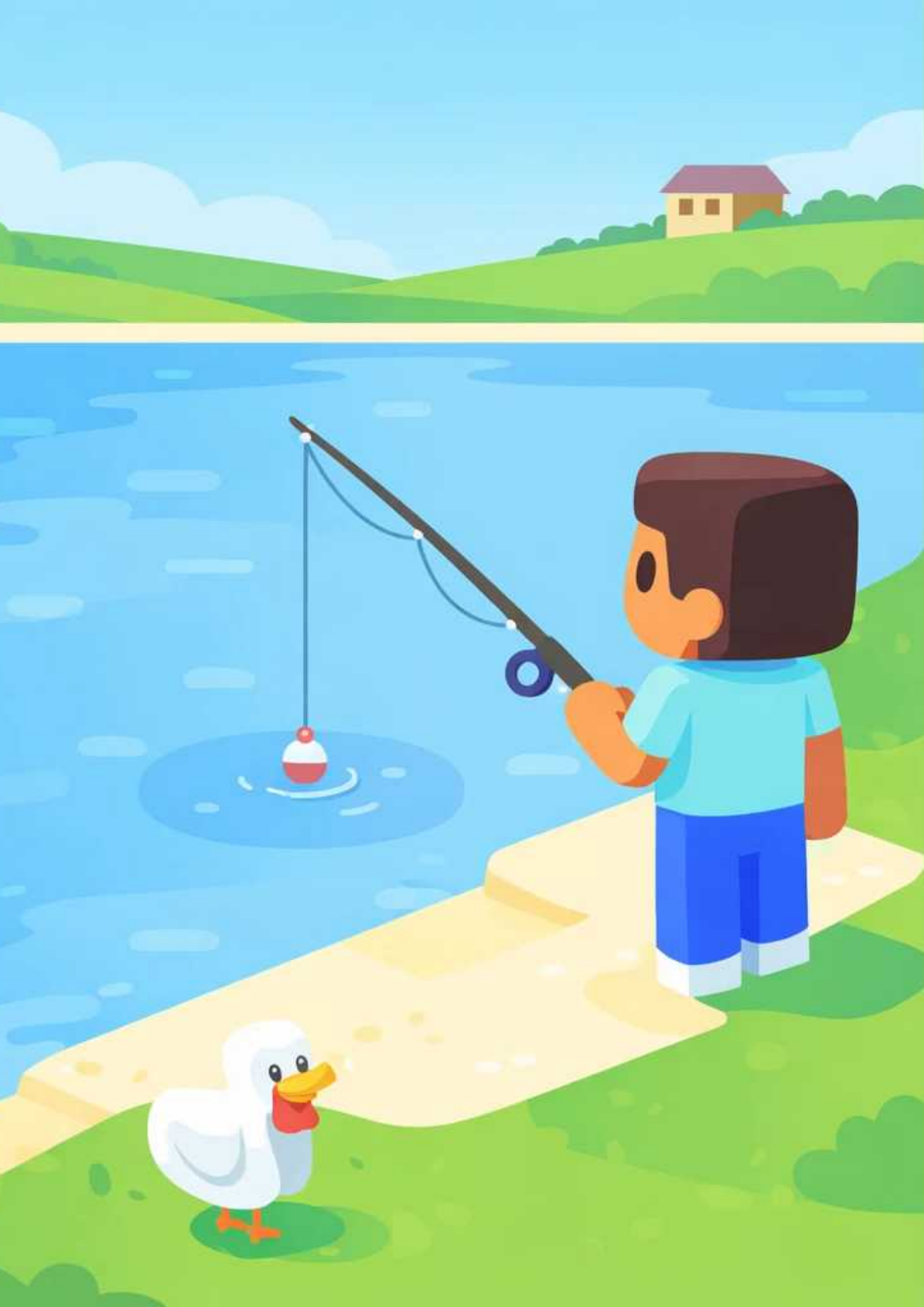


Cows, pigs, and

to fight.

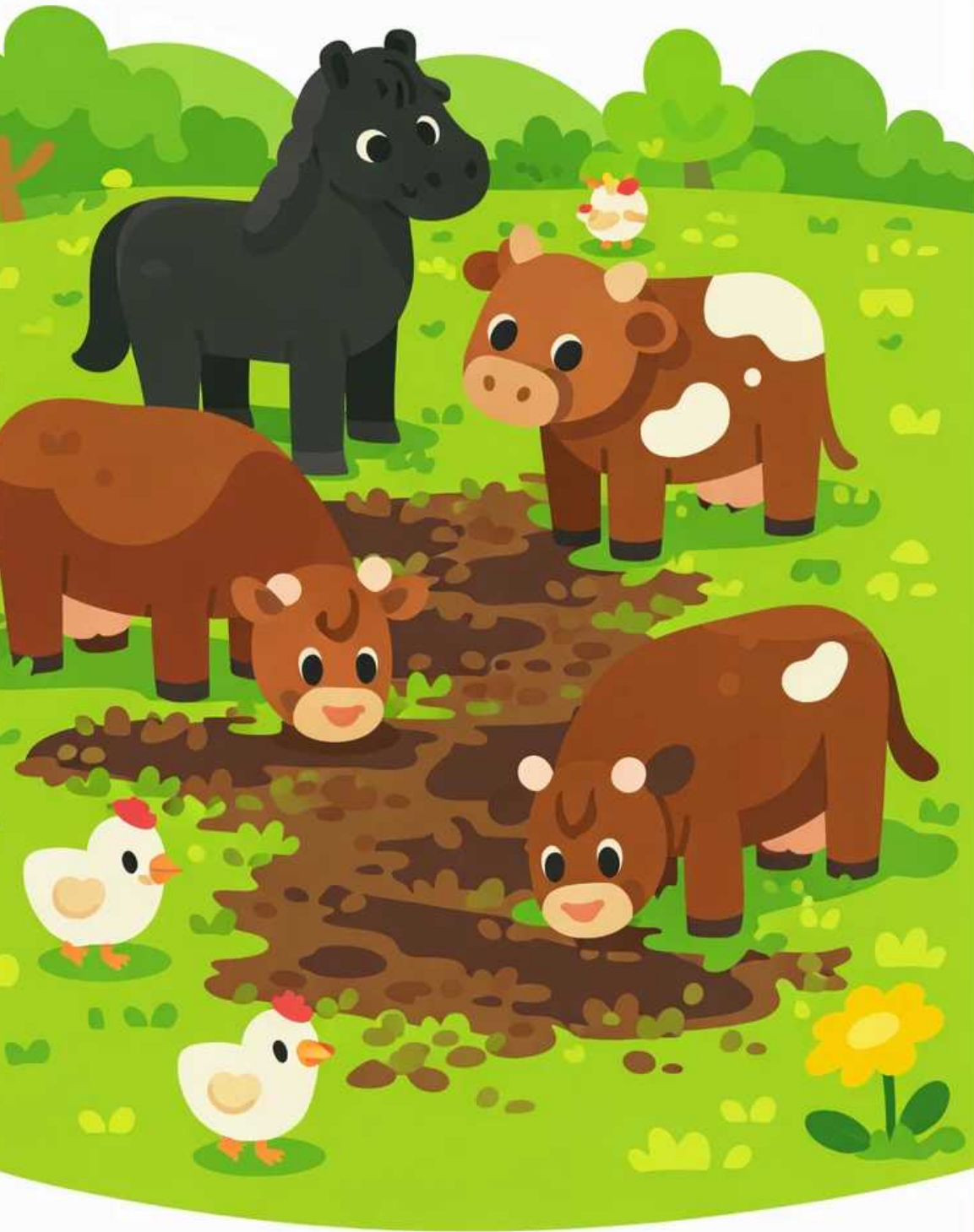




Some plains
