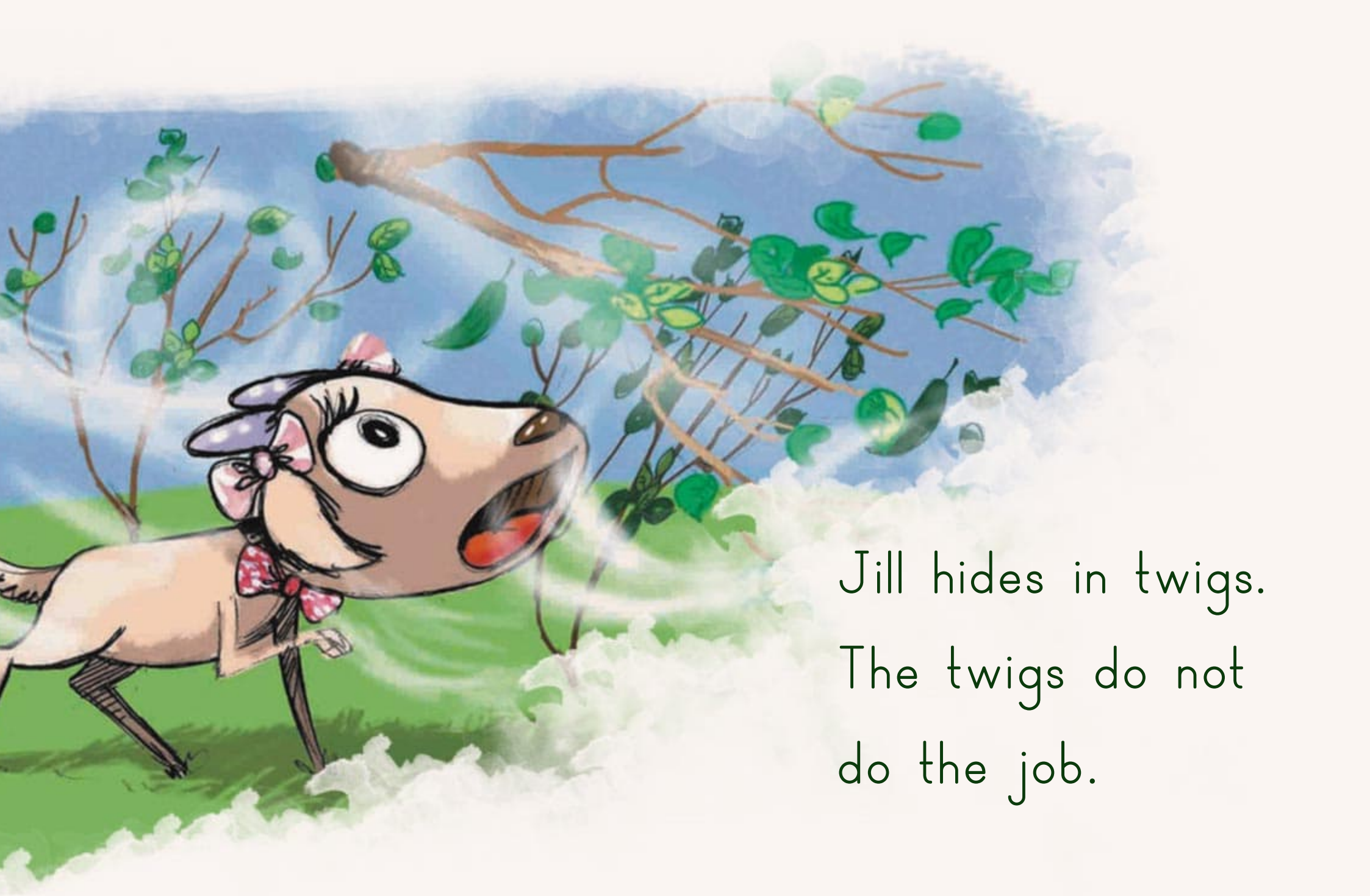

She will not fade.



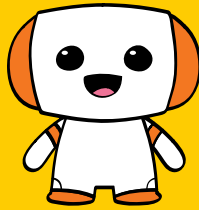
It is not a big hut.
