whole lot?





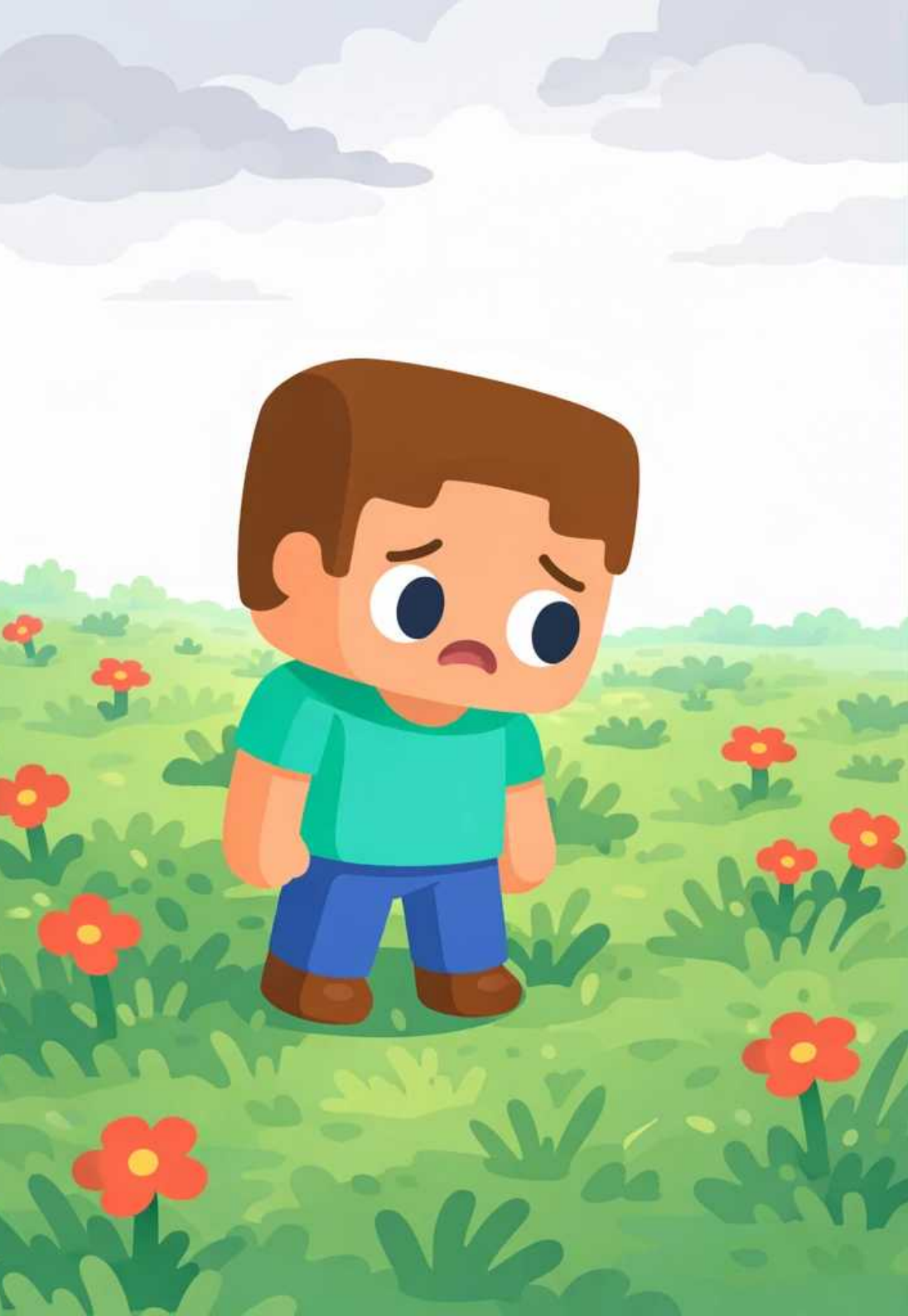
He spots a bin

What is this?

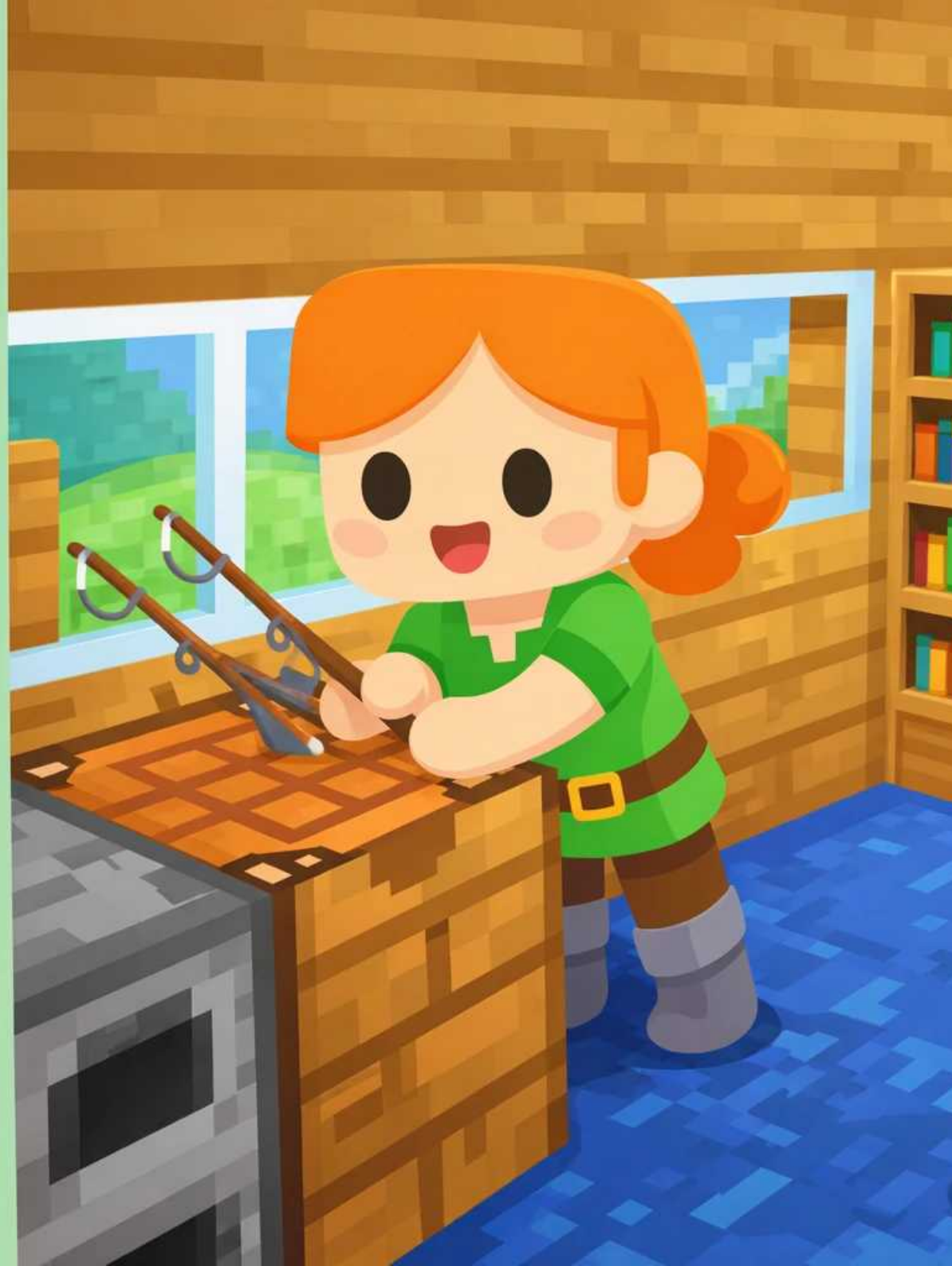
A rod in a
