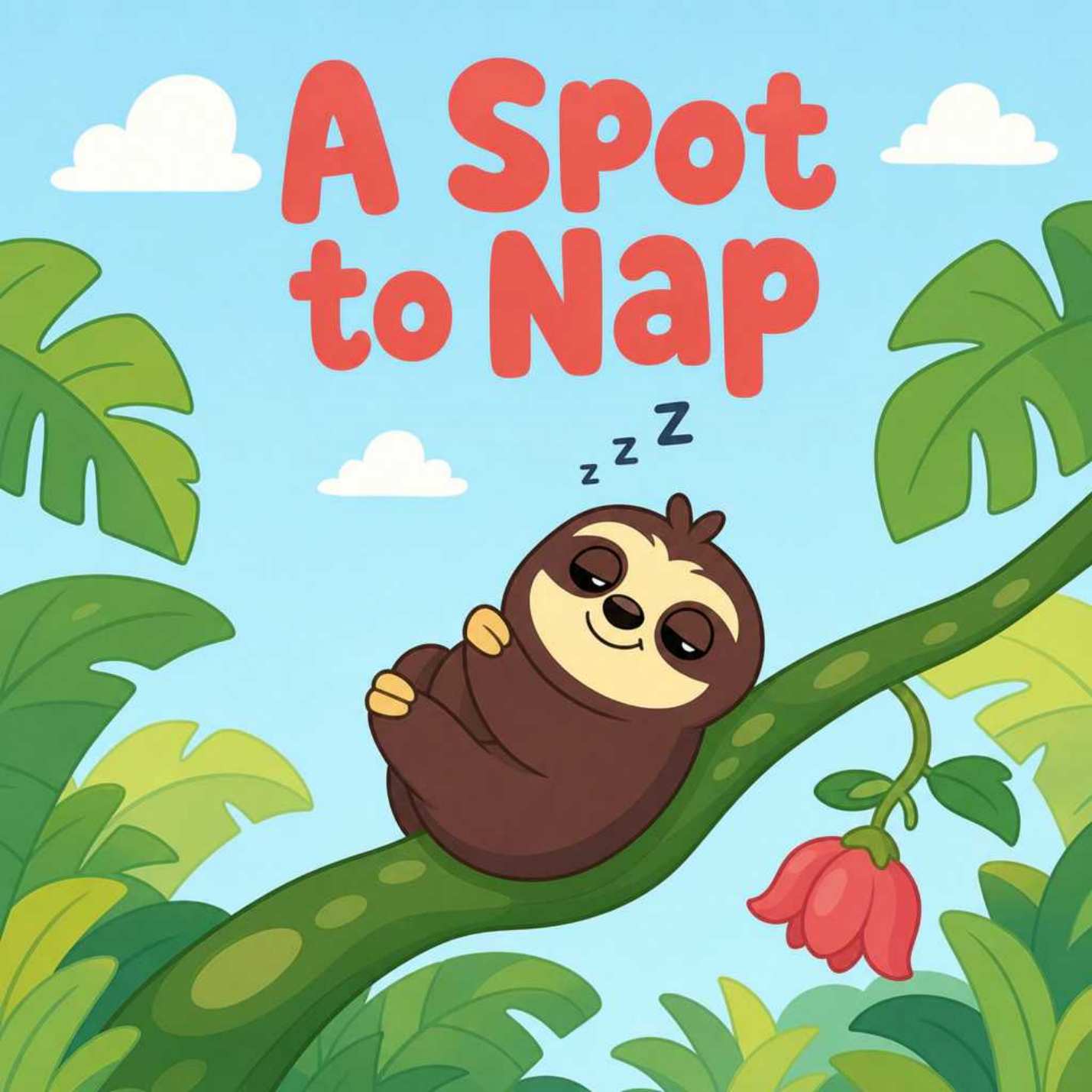


A Spot to Nap

not the spot.

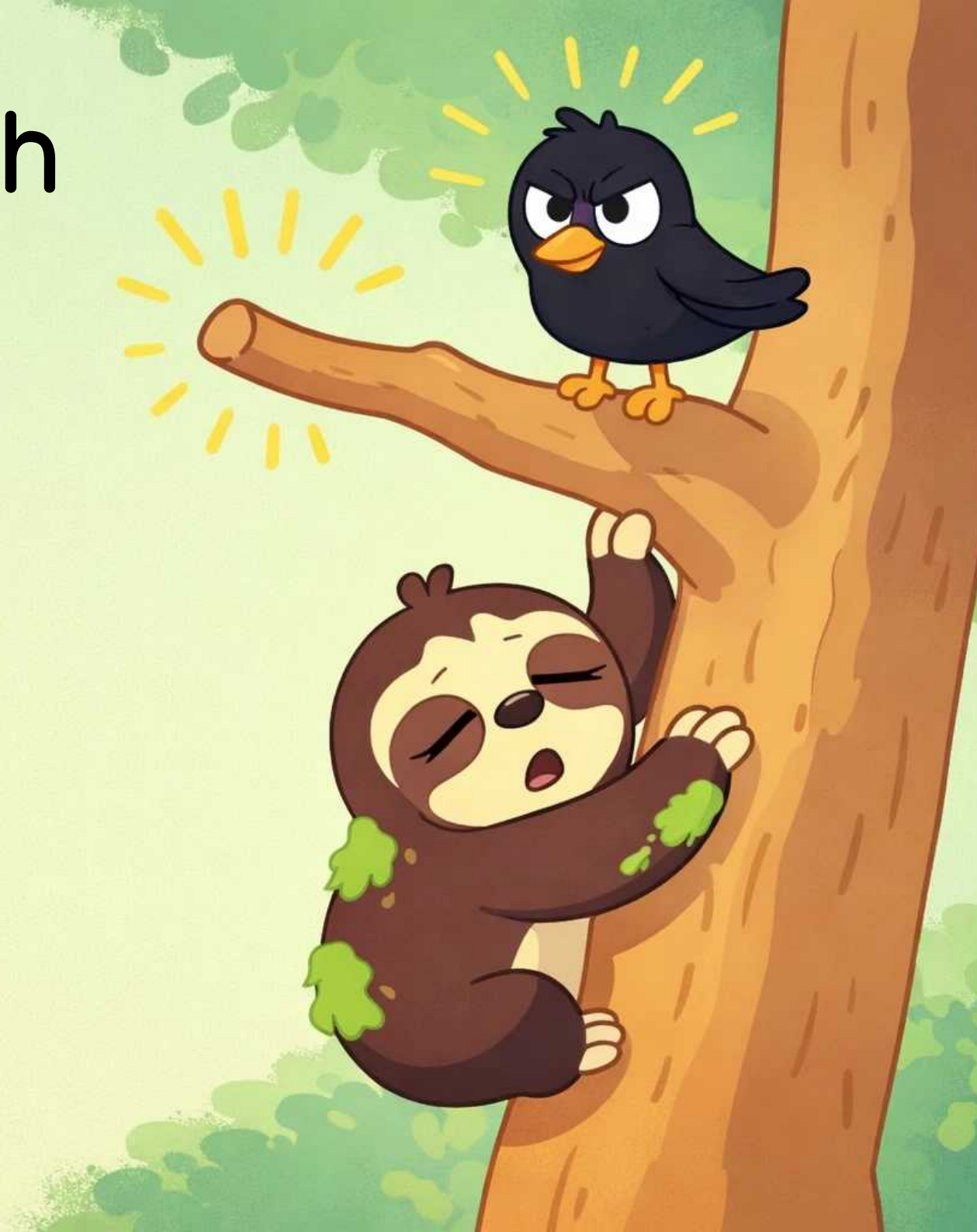
Sloth looks up high.
