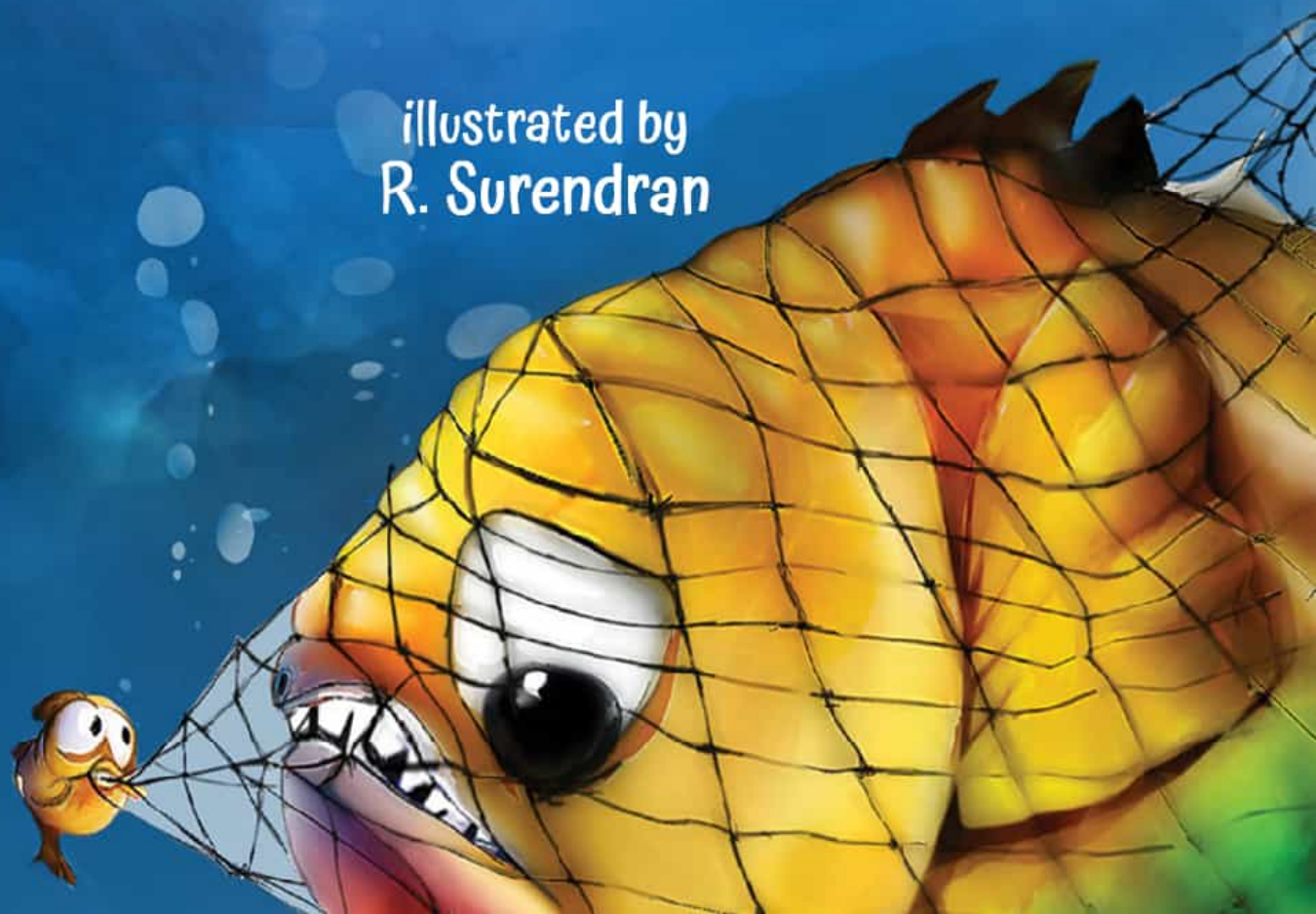


Big Fish and Little Fish

'Can you help me?' she asks.

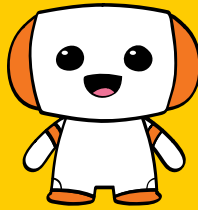
Sword Fish and his mum have sharp teeth.
