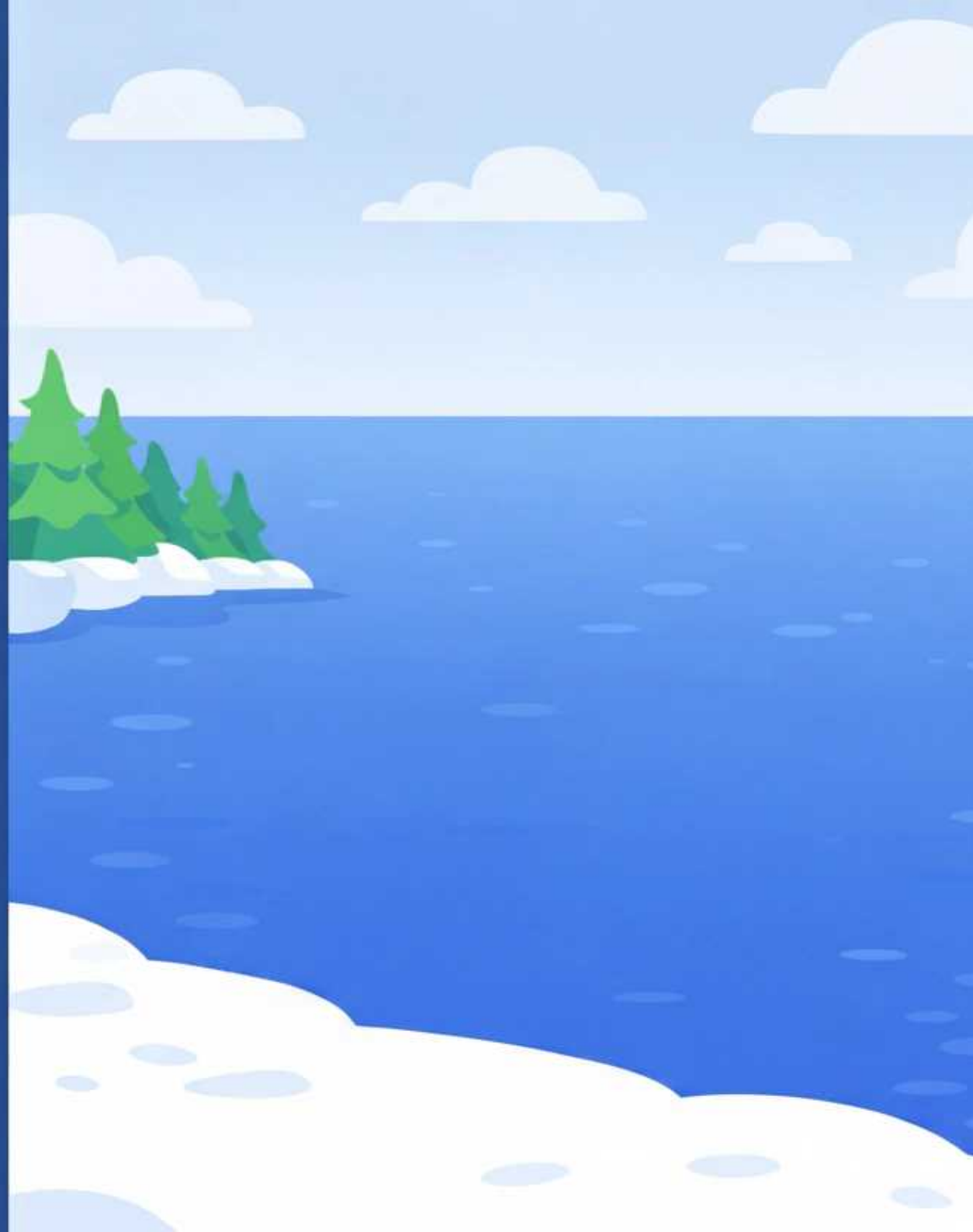
There are a lot of kinds of fish. This type is called a cod. Cod is a big part of lots of people's diet. Have you had cod from a fish and chip shop?

tools at hand.

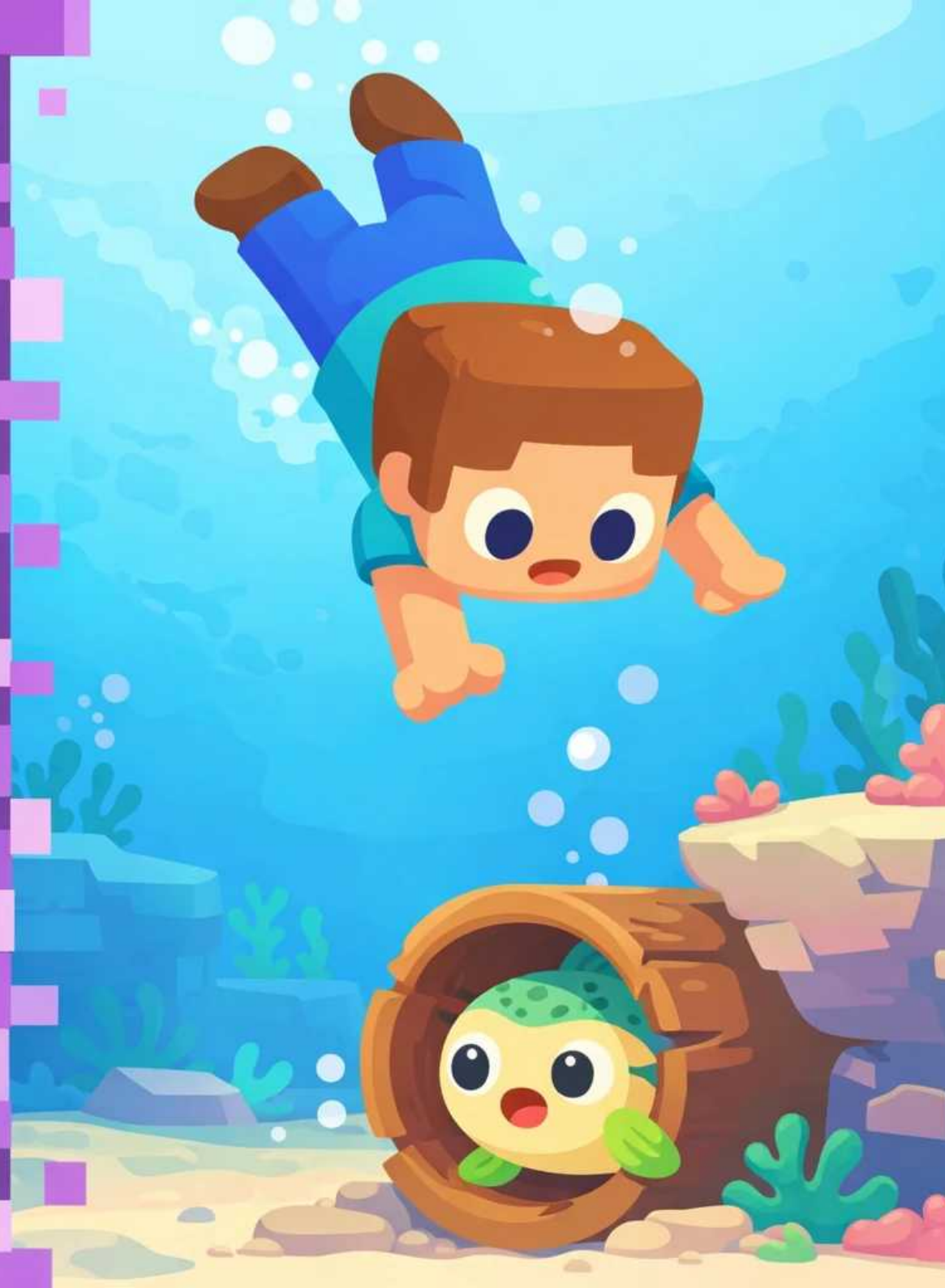

kelp as well.

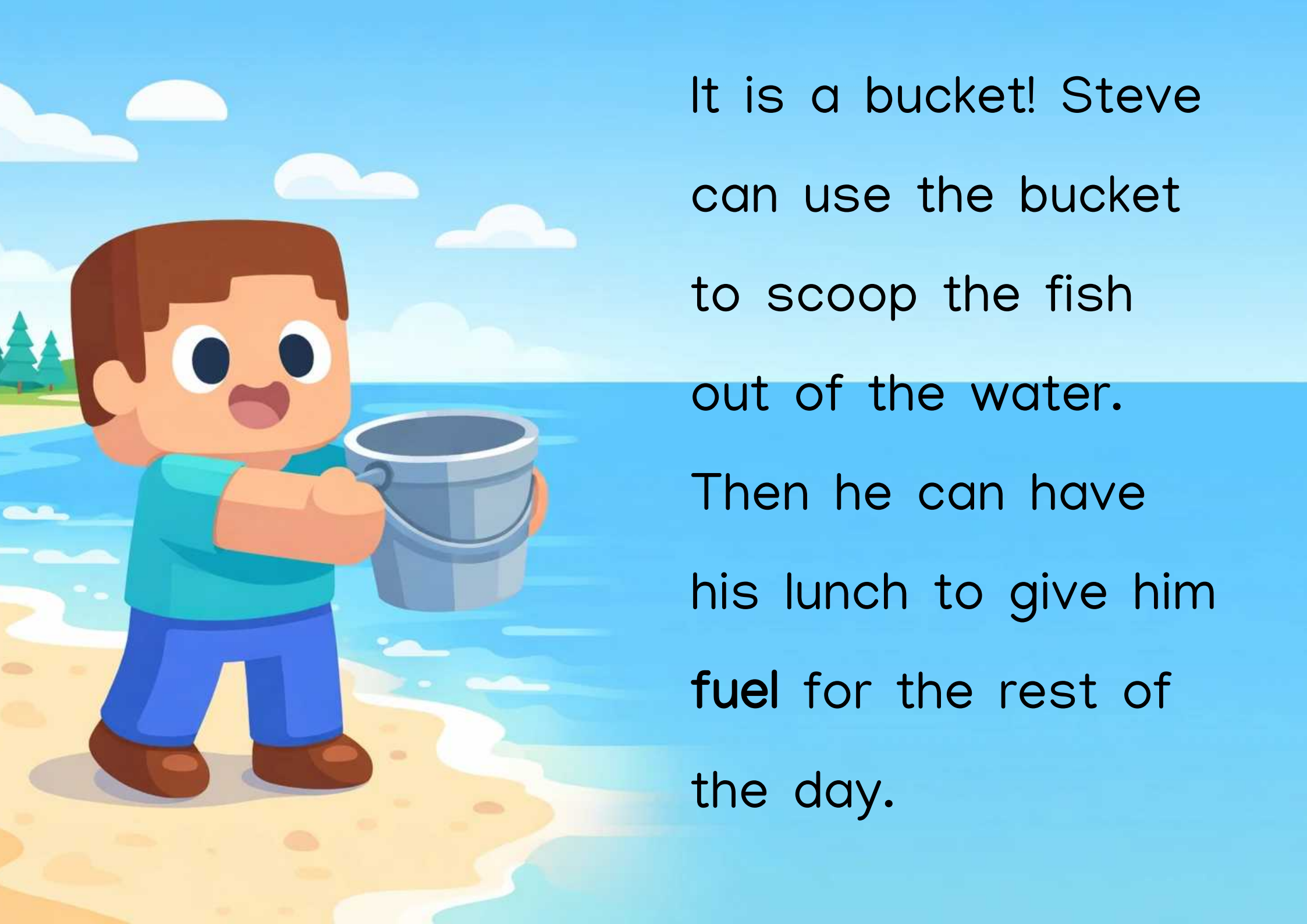
