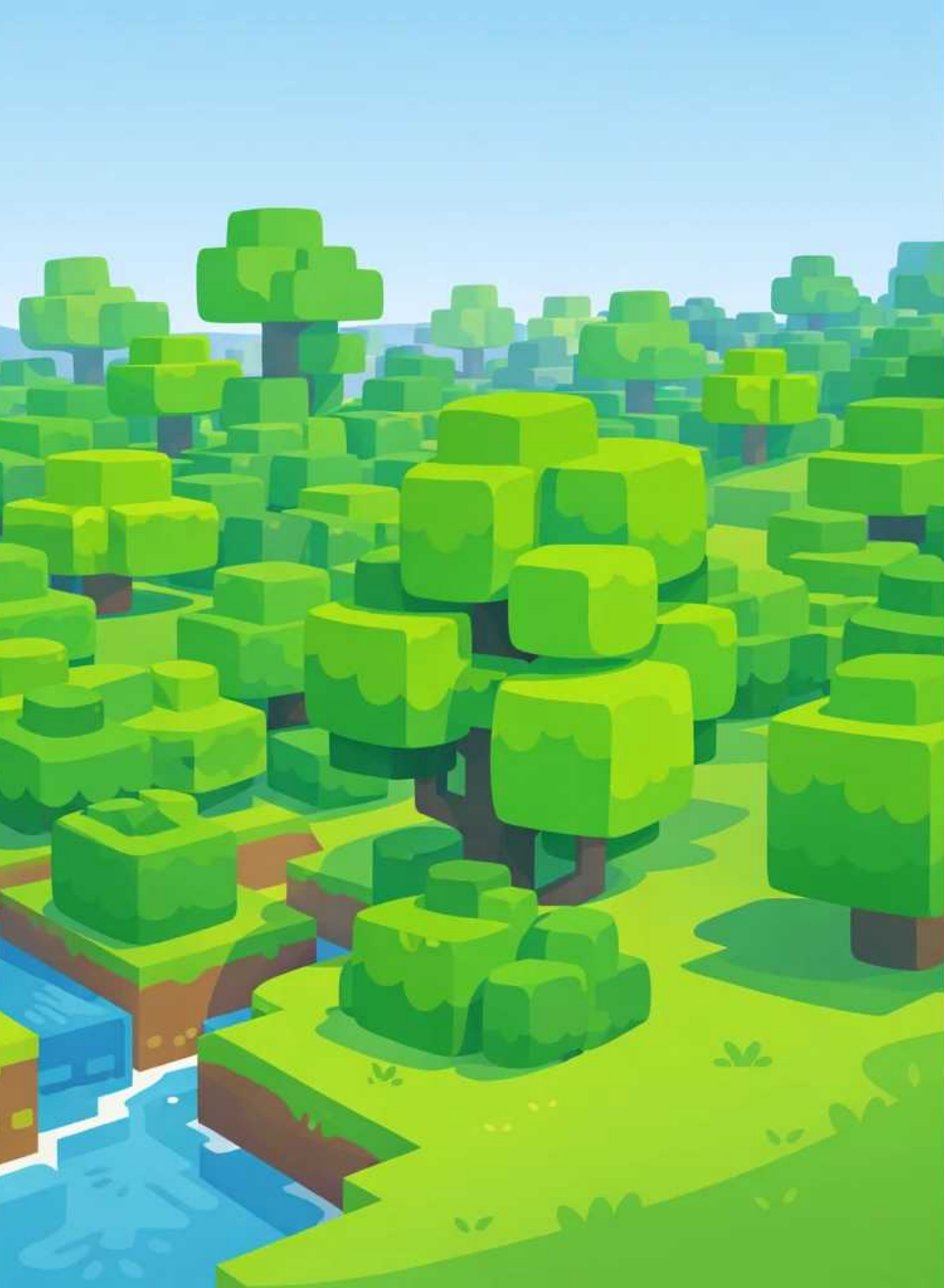

Forests are full of green trees. You will see more trees here than in any other biome. The trees grow close to each other.

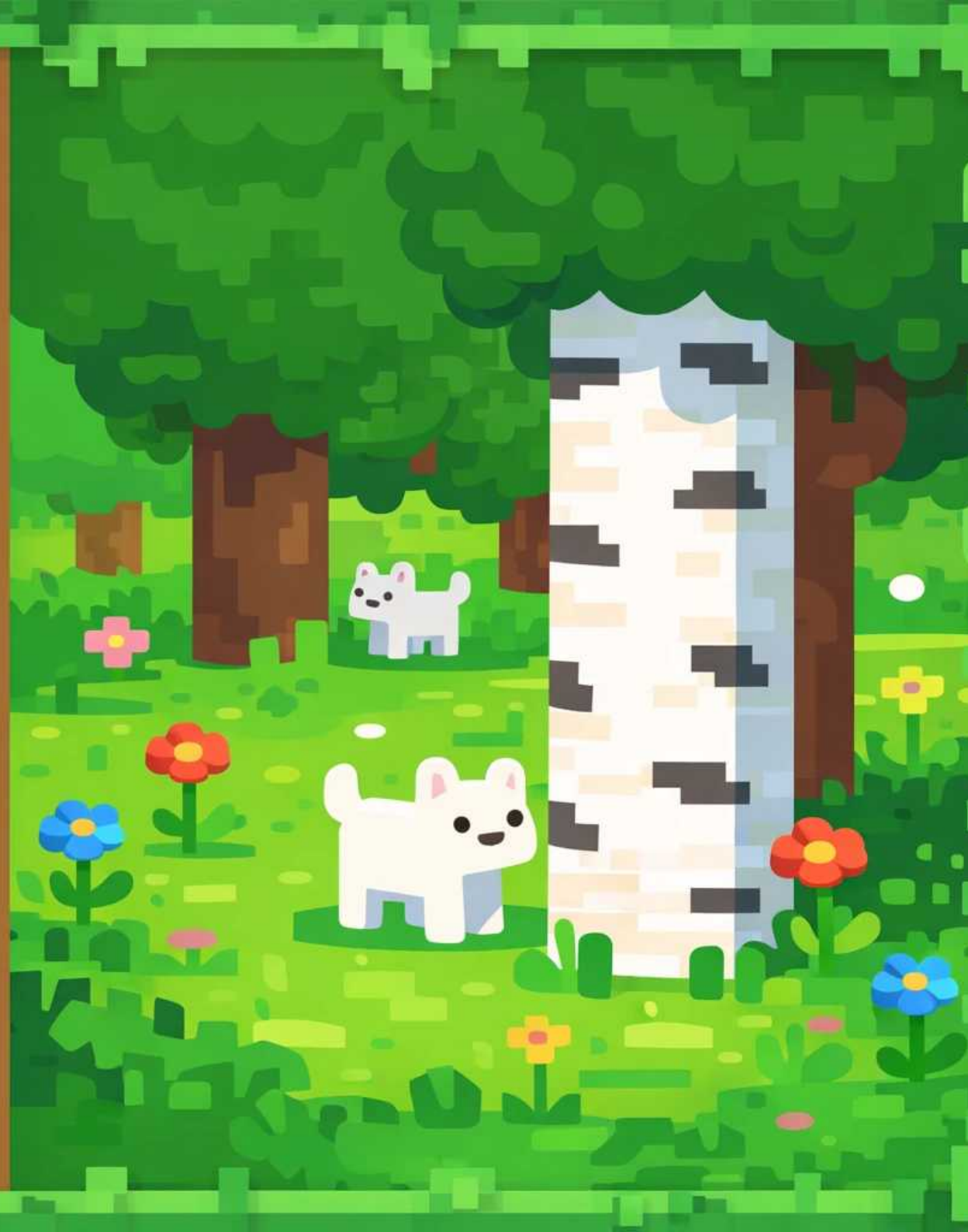
Trees can be cut down for wood. You can craft a lot of things with wood. You will need it from the very start.

you.

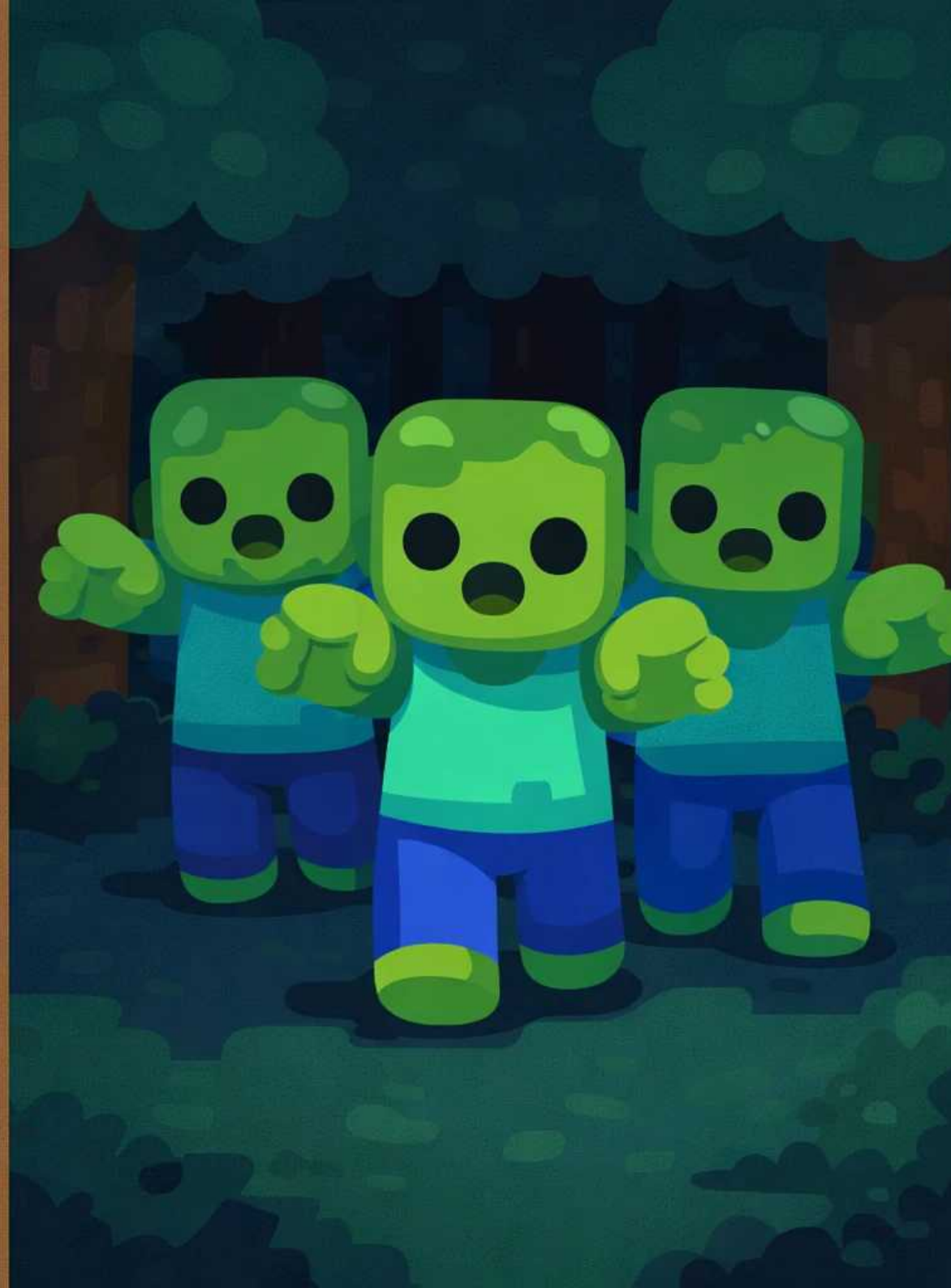
Some forests

birch trees.

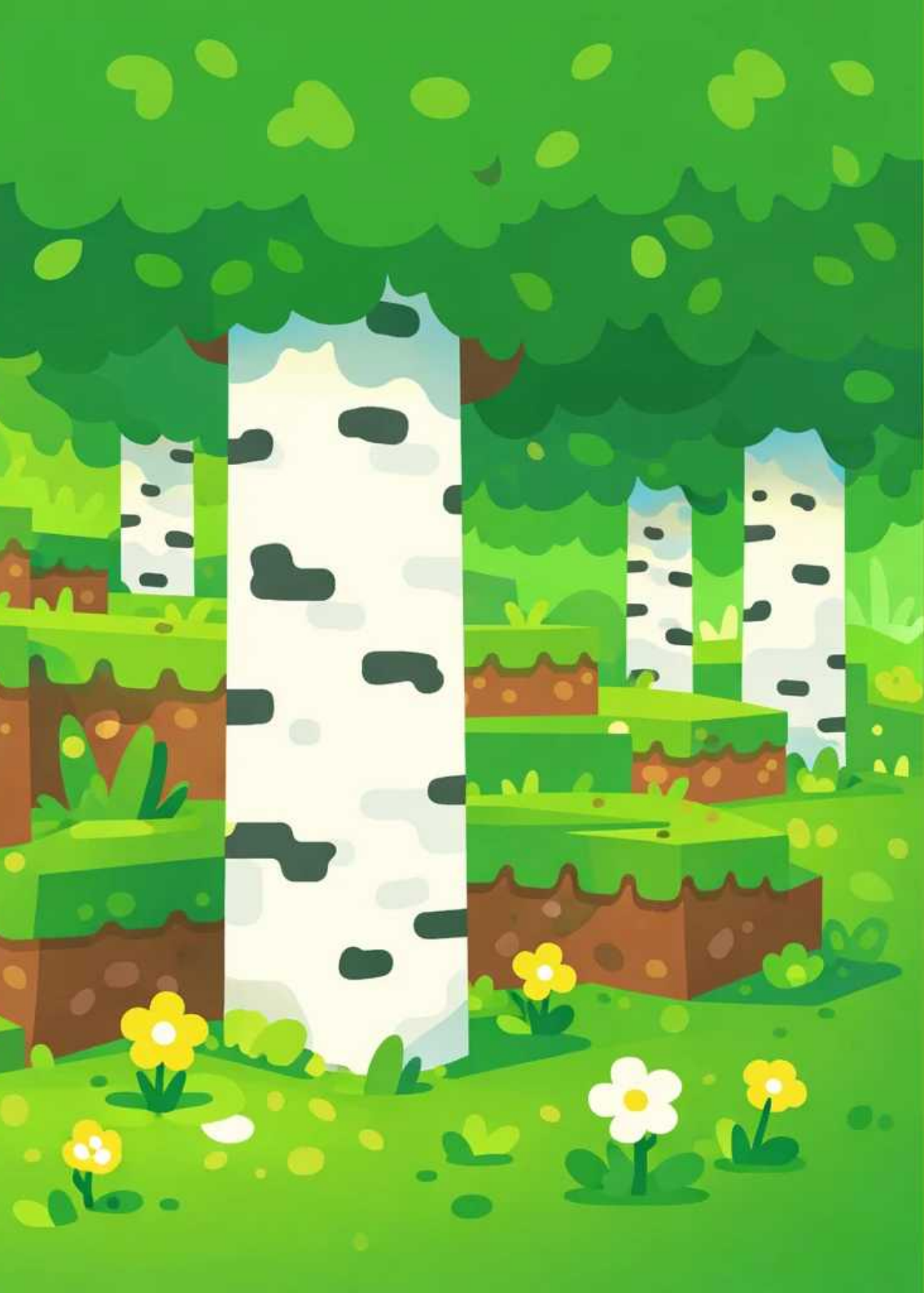




Some have

like dark oak!

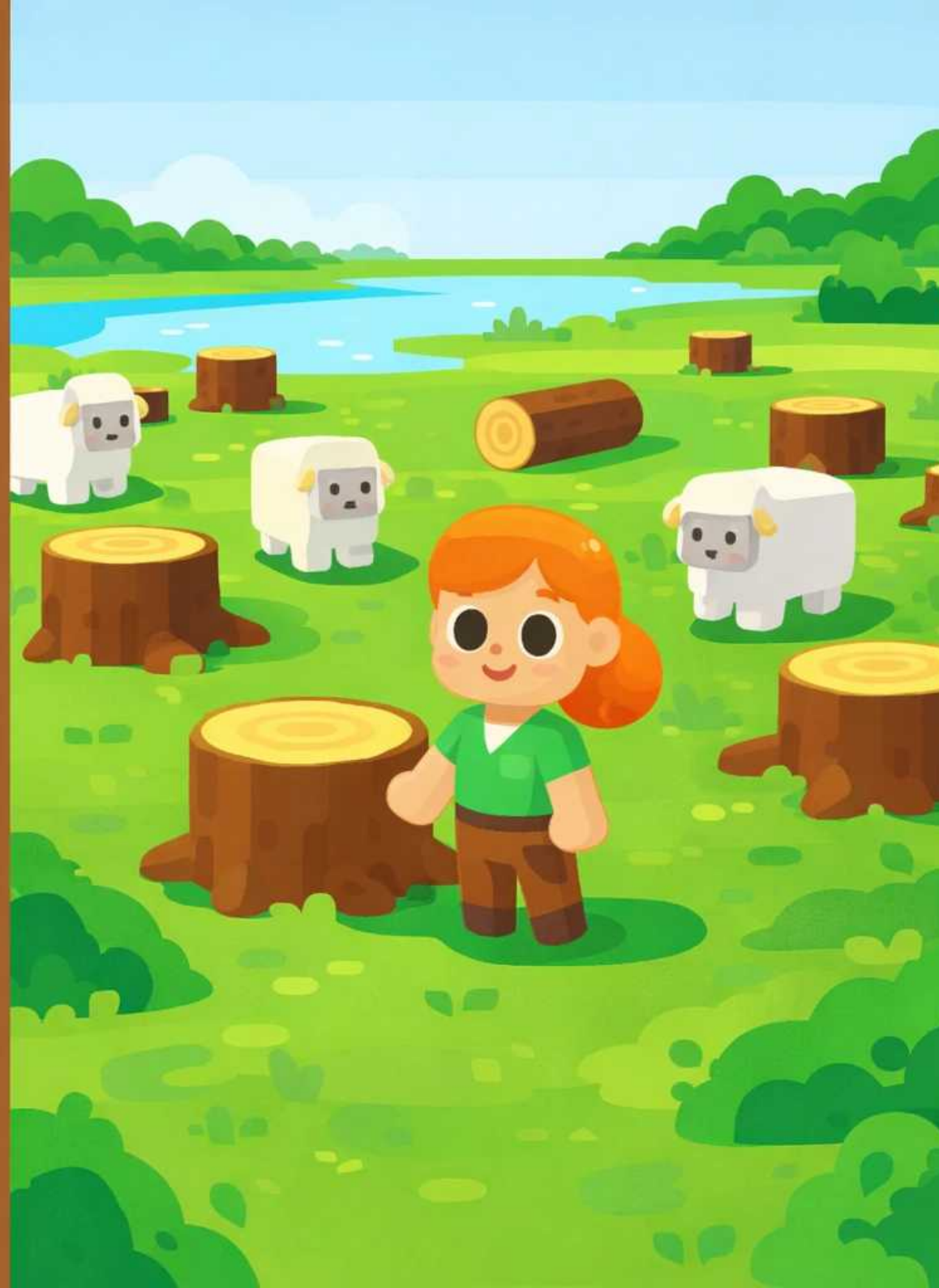
In the dark

You can get all of the grass seeds and flowers that you need. See the seeds by the green trees. It is all free in the forest.

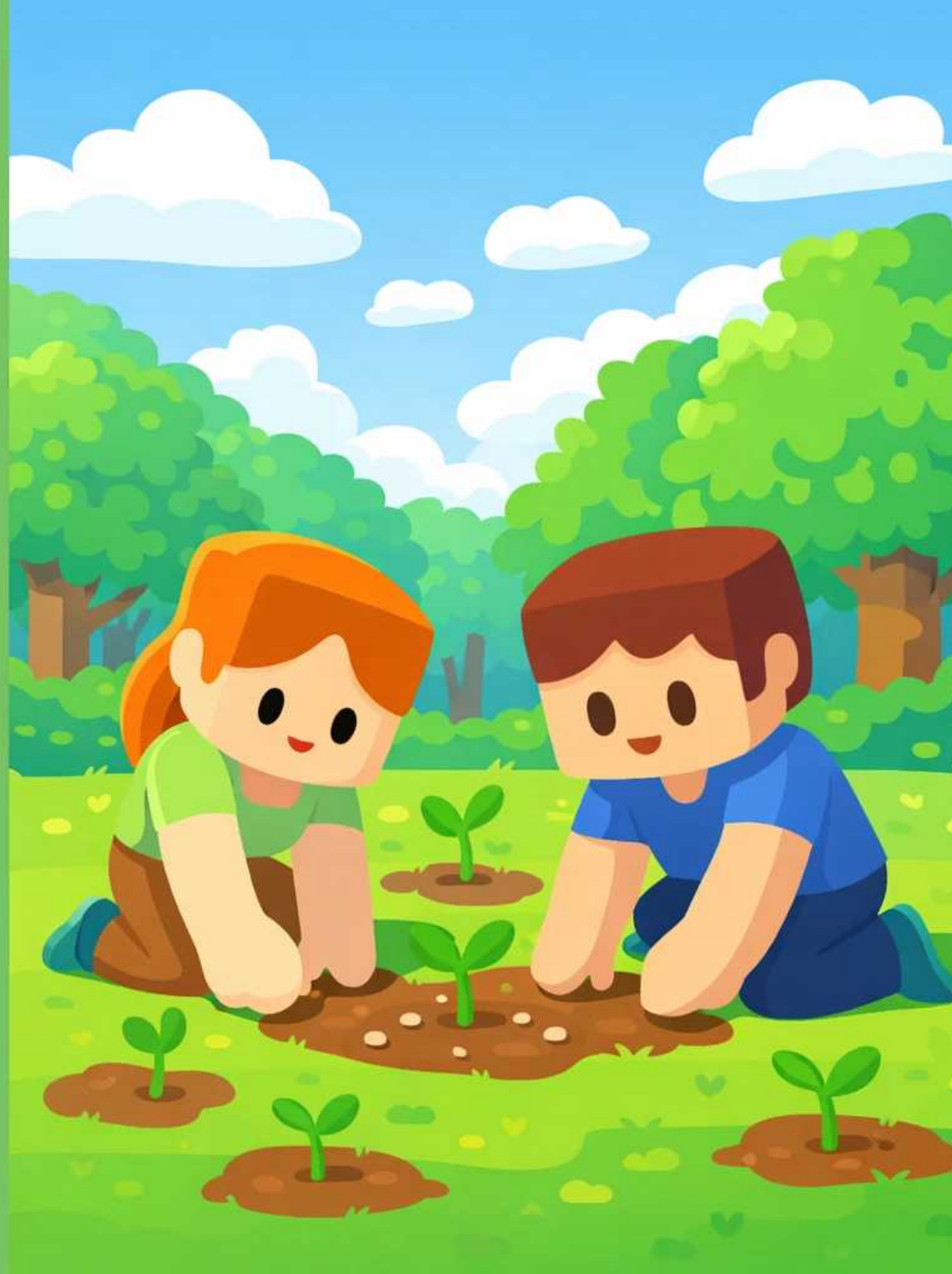
In forests in

many trees.

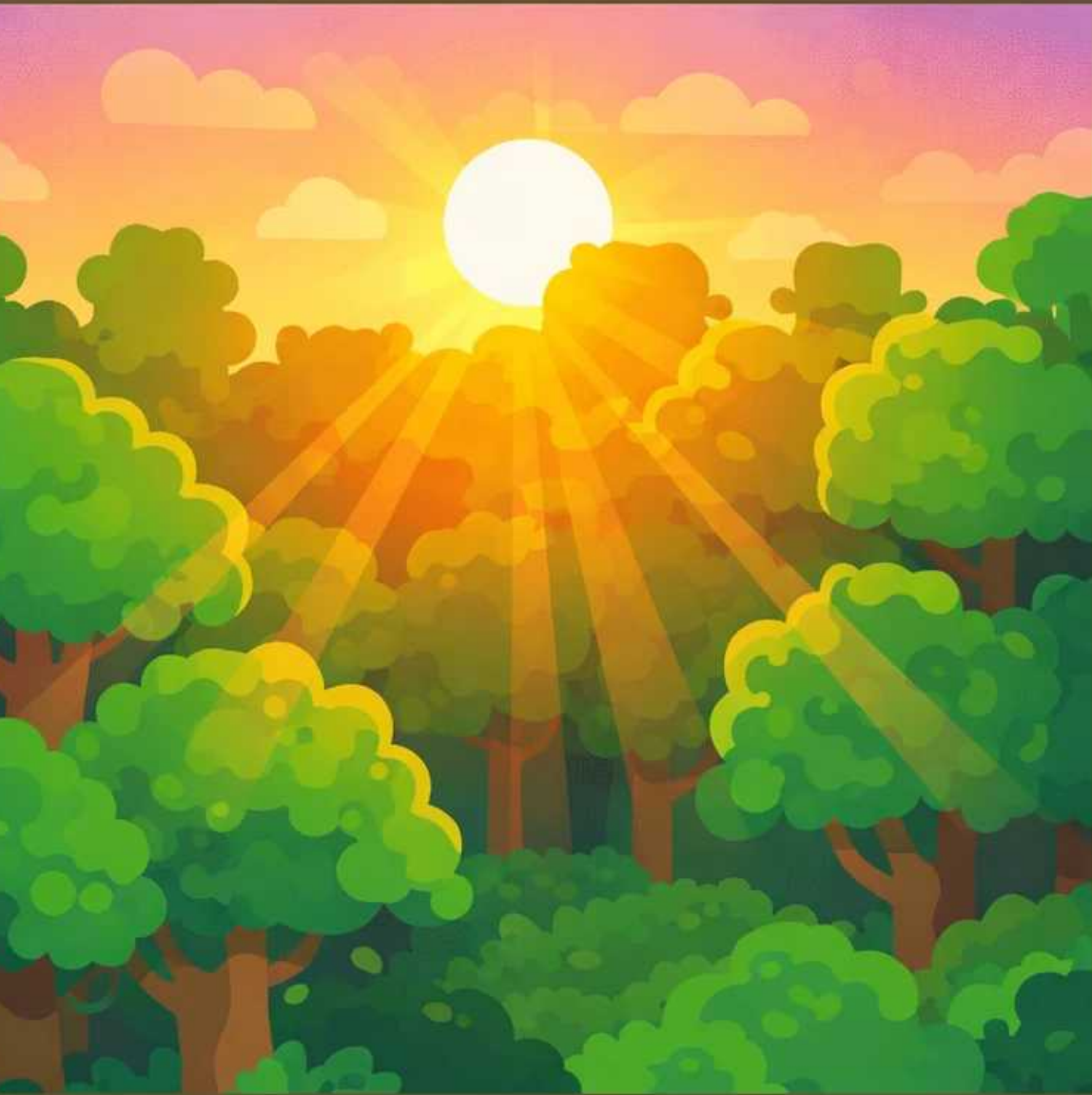




If we cut down
