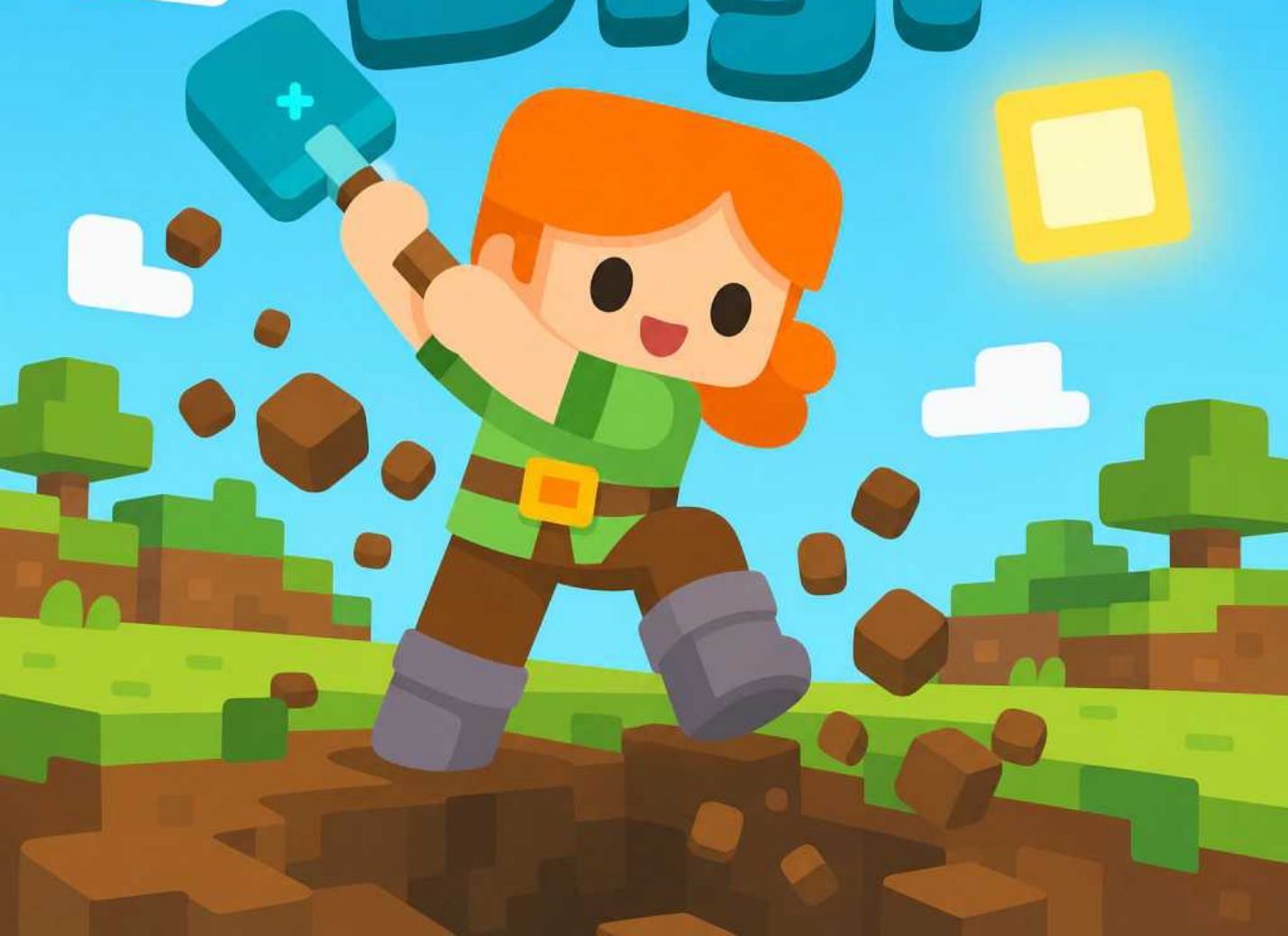


An Unofficial Minecraft Books

fish.

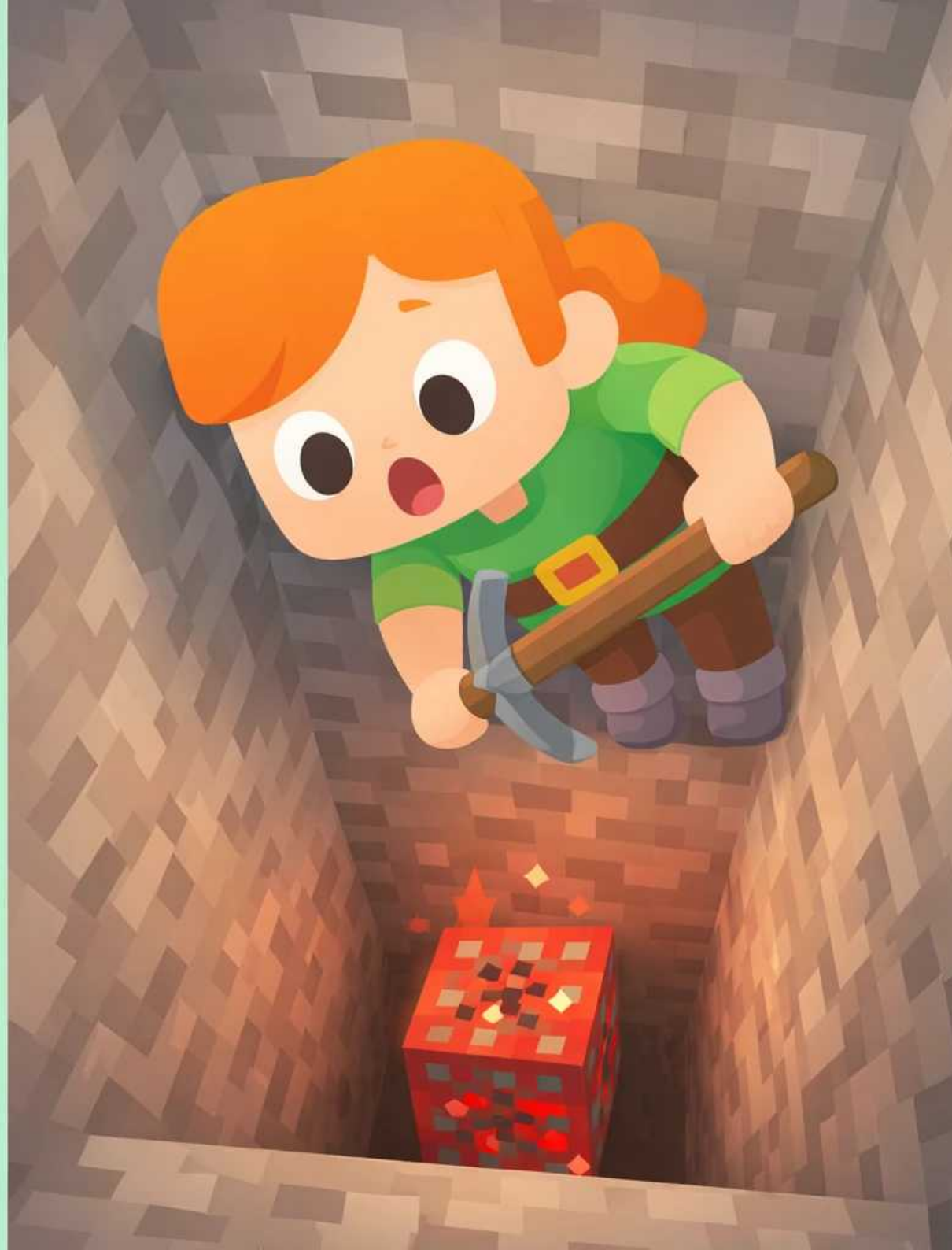
The cat had
