so the hunt is on!

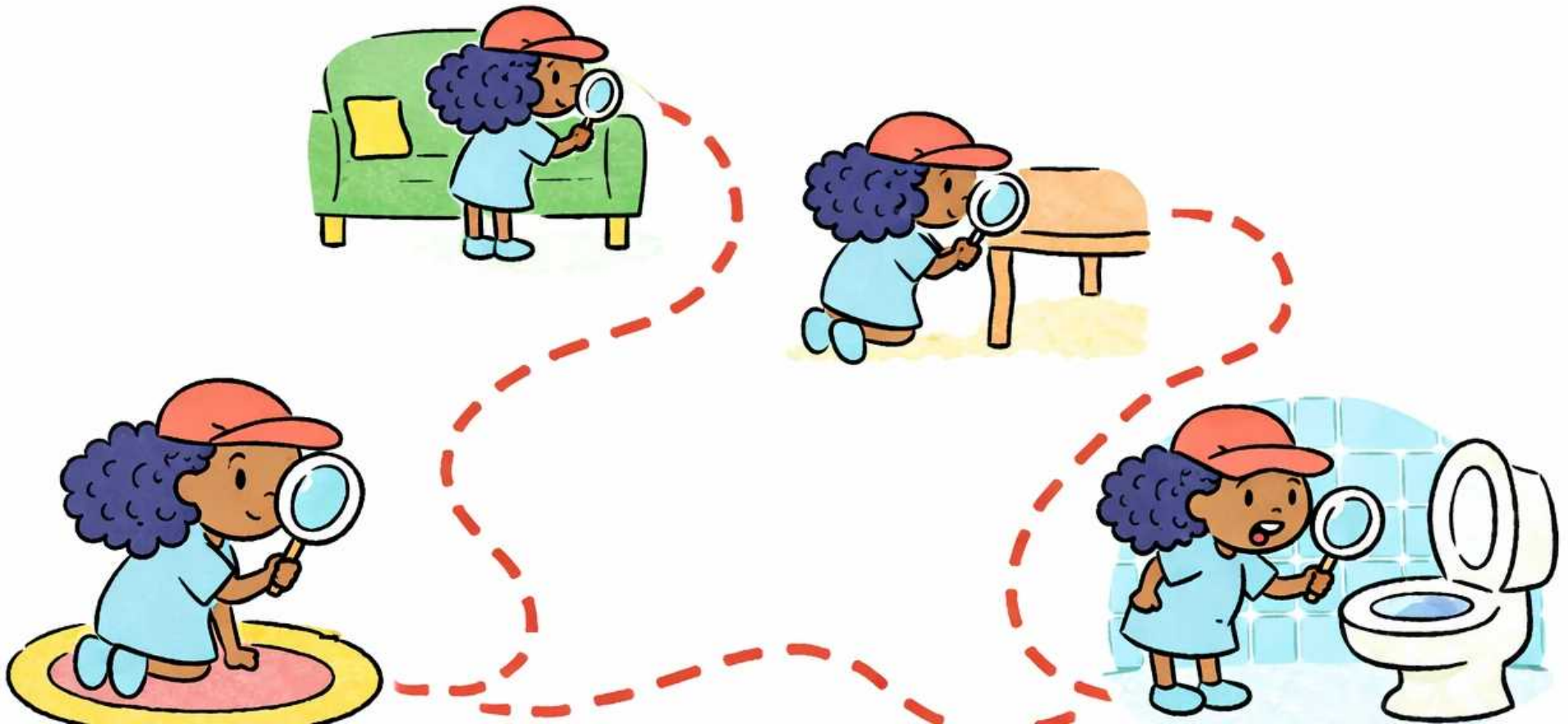


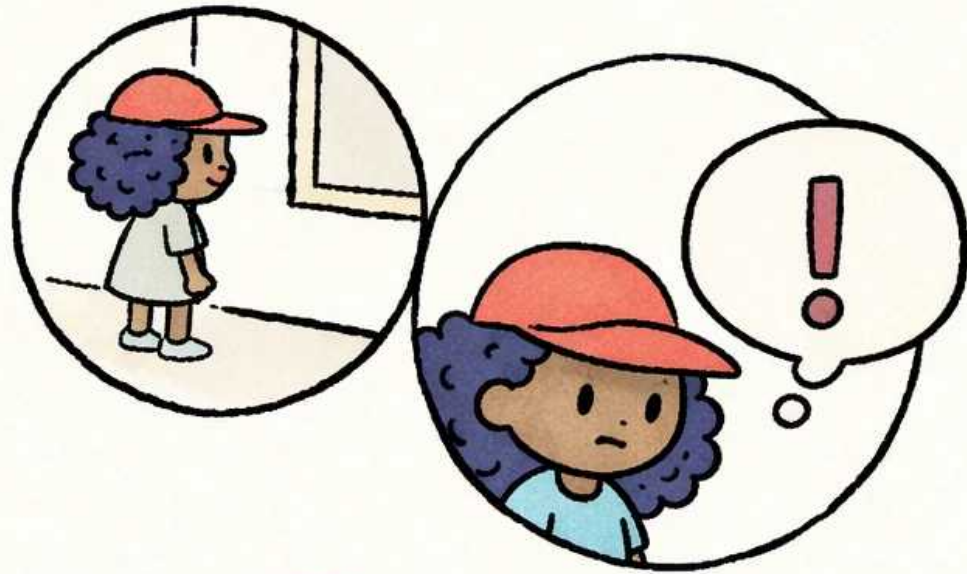


She thinks of
