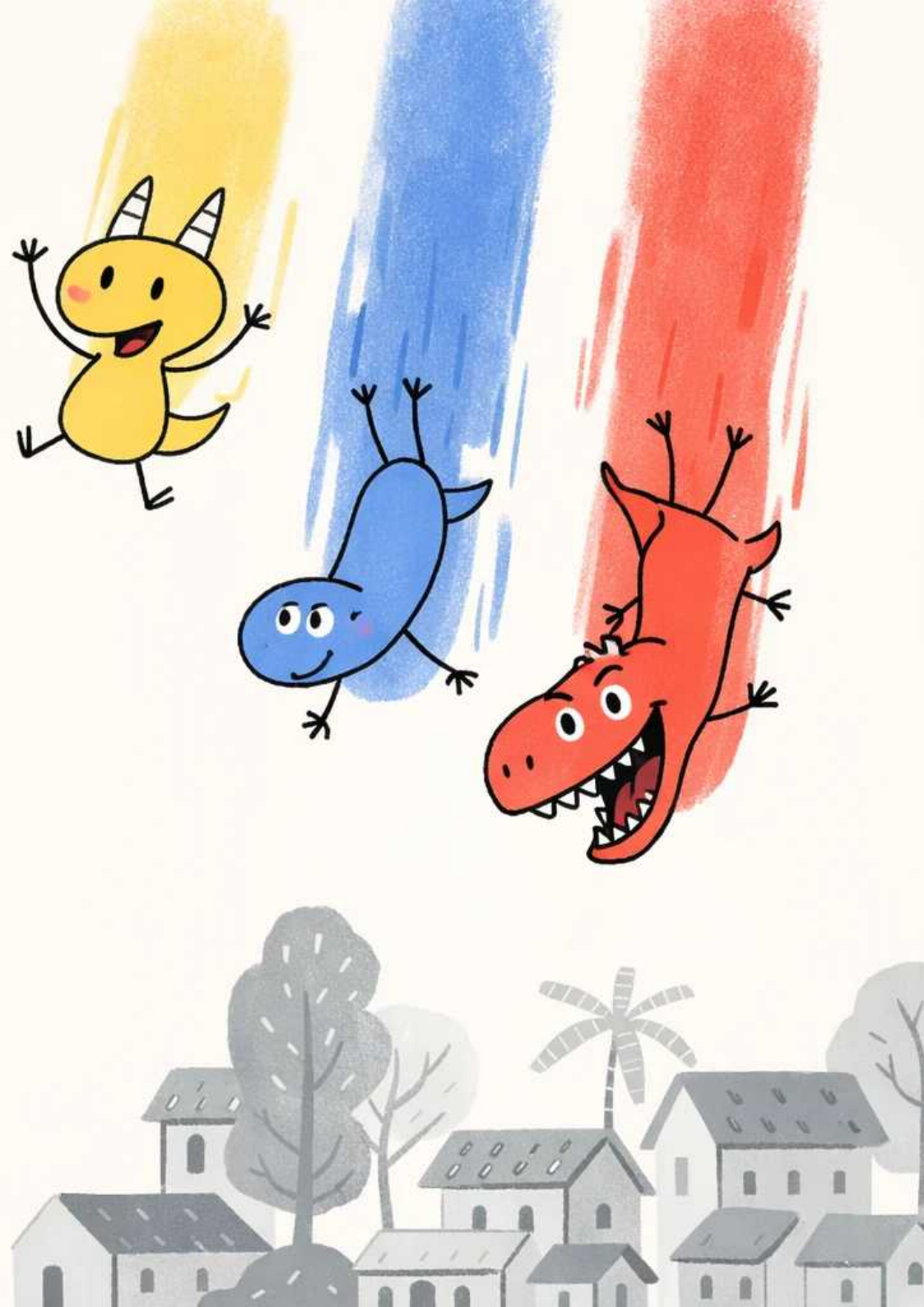
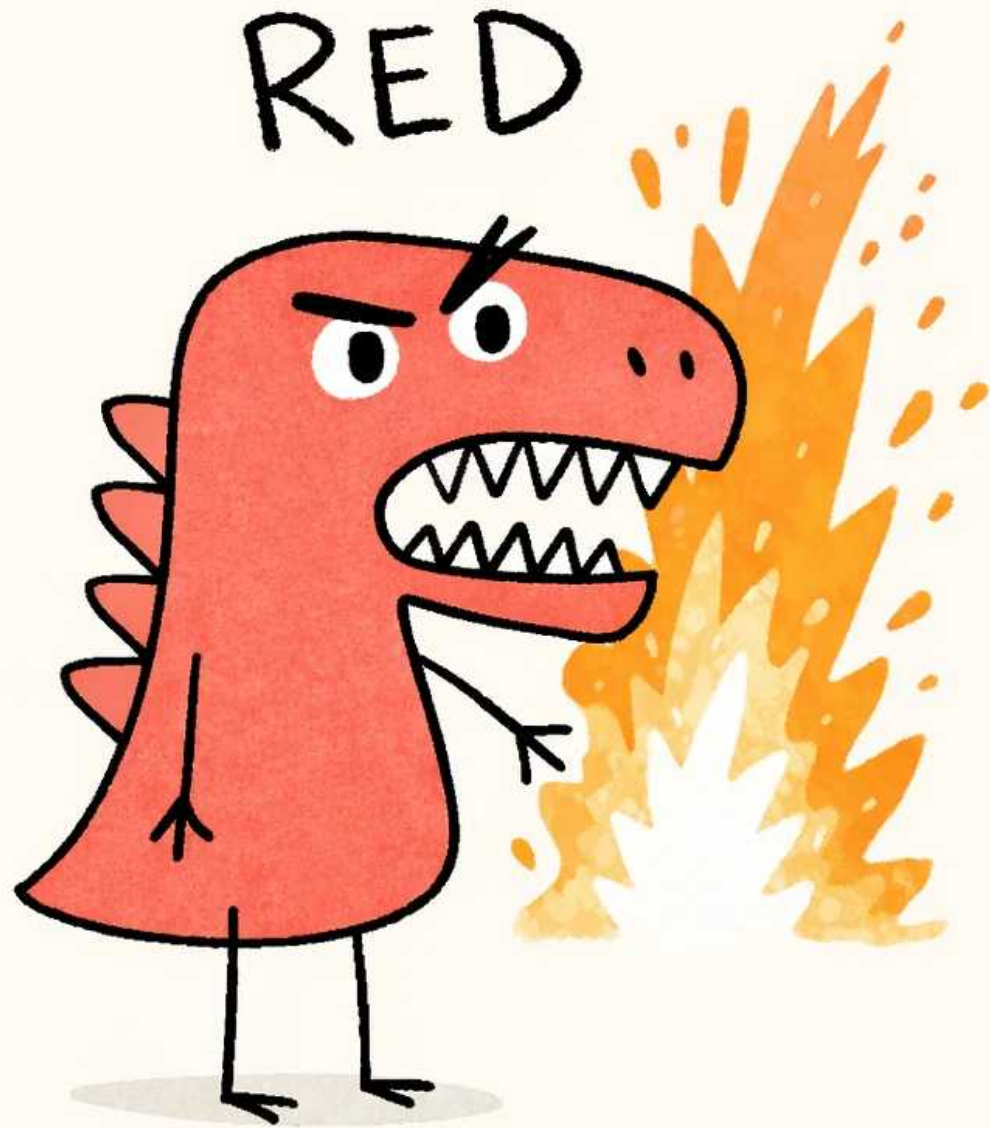


Don't Mix All Three!



Just three colors
can make a whole
lot more. They are
called the **primary**
colors. Red, blue,
and yellow are
primary.





Red is a dangerous, powerful color. We call it a hot color. Think of hot, red things like lava.

Yellow is a warm color, too. It is more gentle. Think of warm things like the sun on a beautiful day.



BLUE



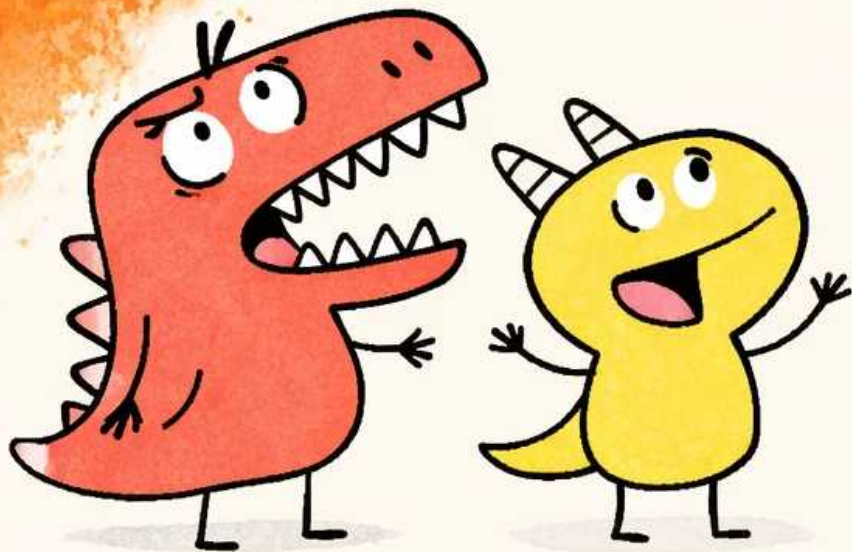
Blue is a cool color. Think of swimming in a wonderful, clear blue lake.

get more colors?

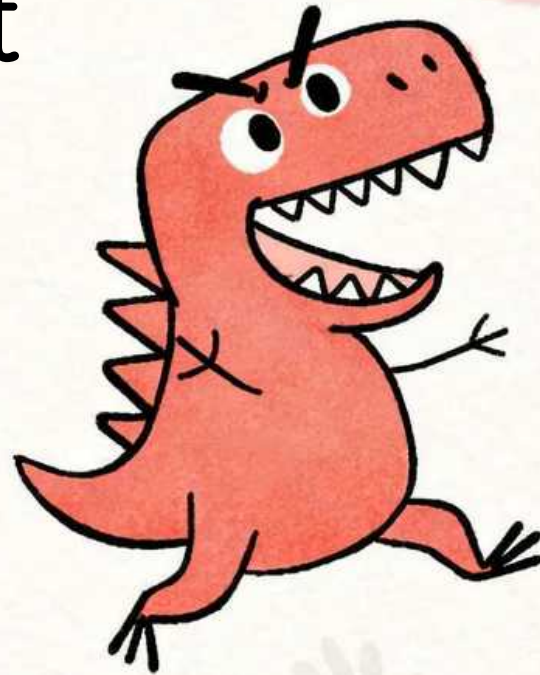
You mix those

you get...

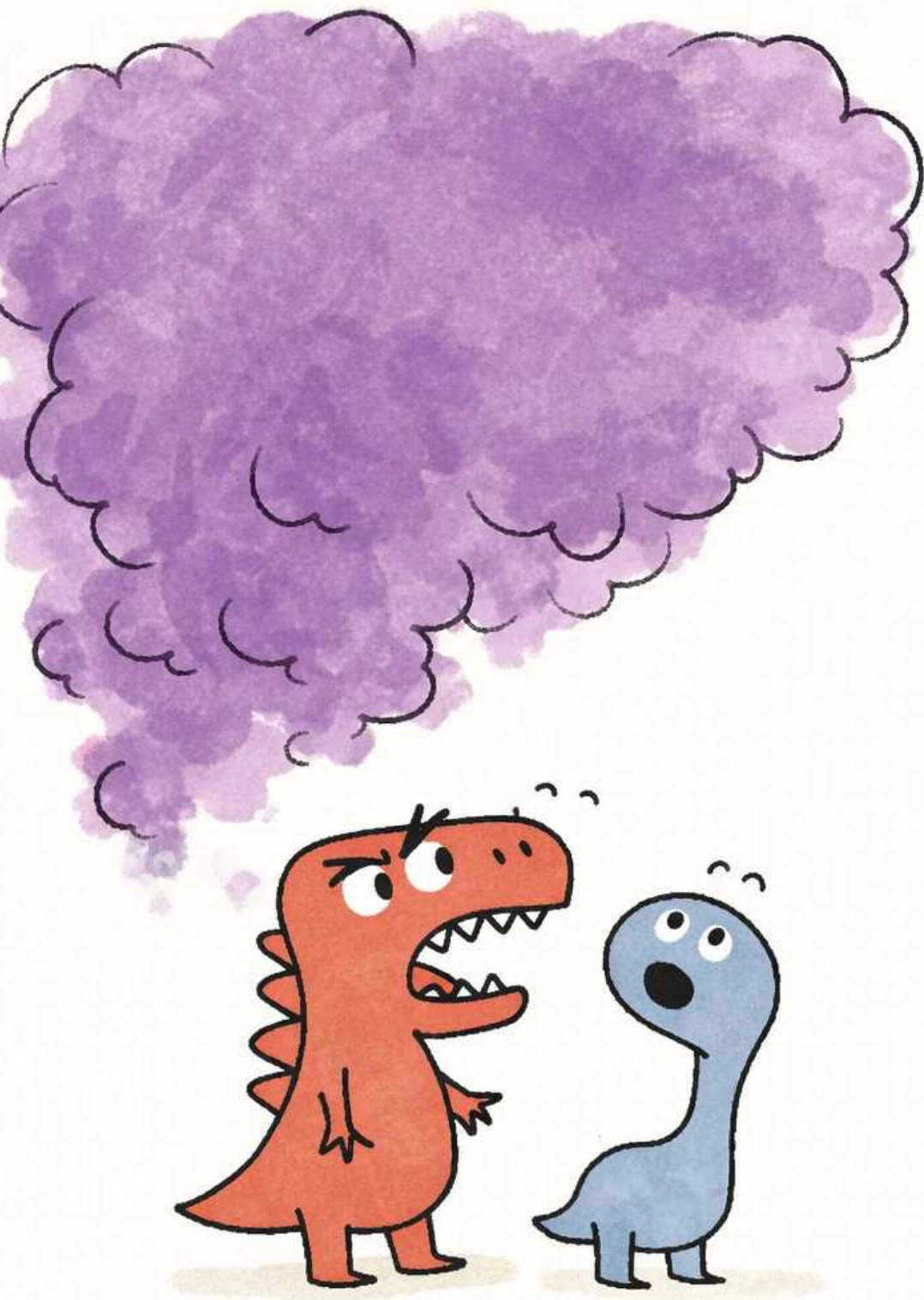


Orange! These

mix together.



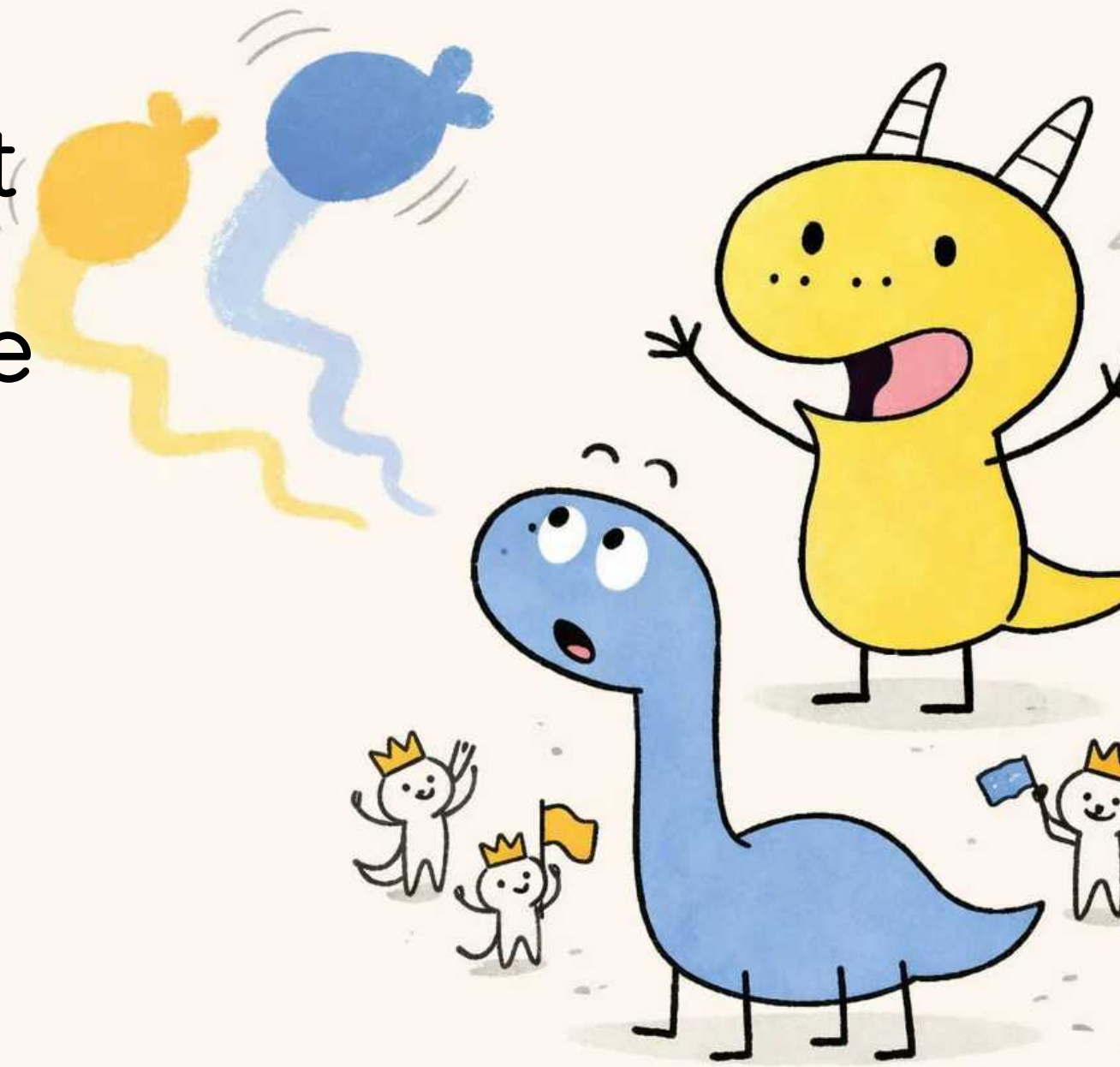
Let's mix

Generally it's a cool color. But add a lot of yellow to warm it up.

And there you have it! Mix the primary pairs together, and you get secondary colors. So, what happens when you mix all three at once?
