what a fool!

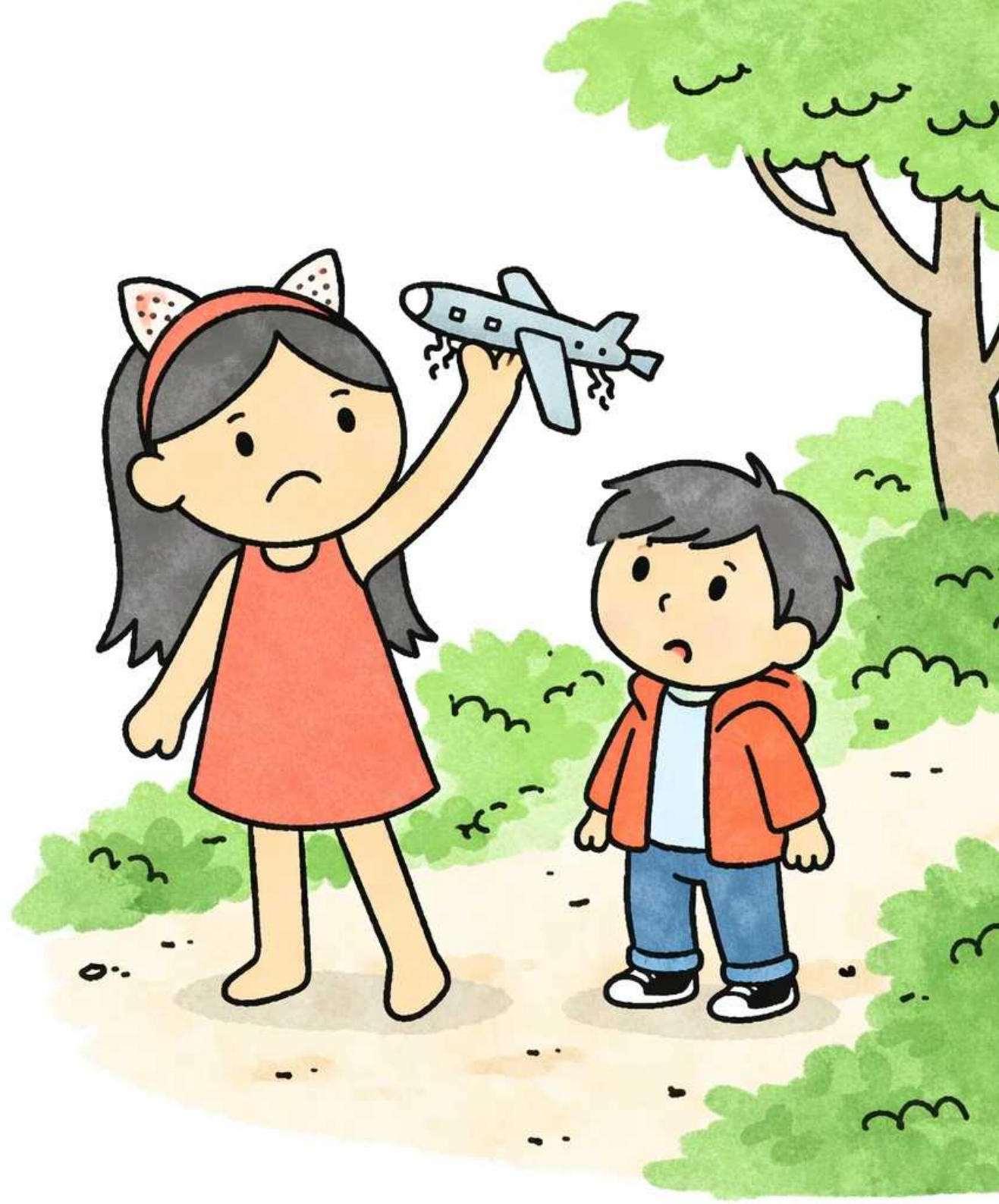
Big Sis gave the
