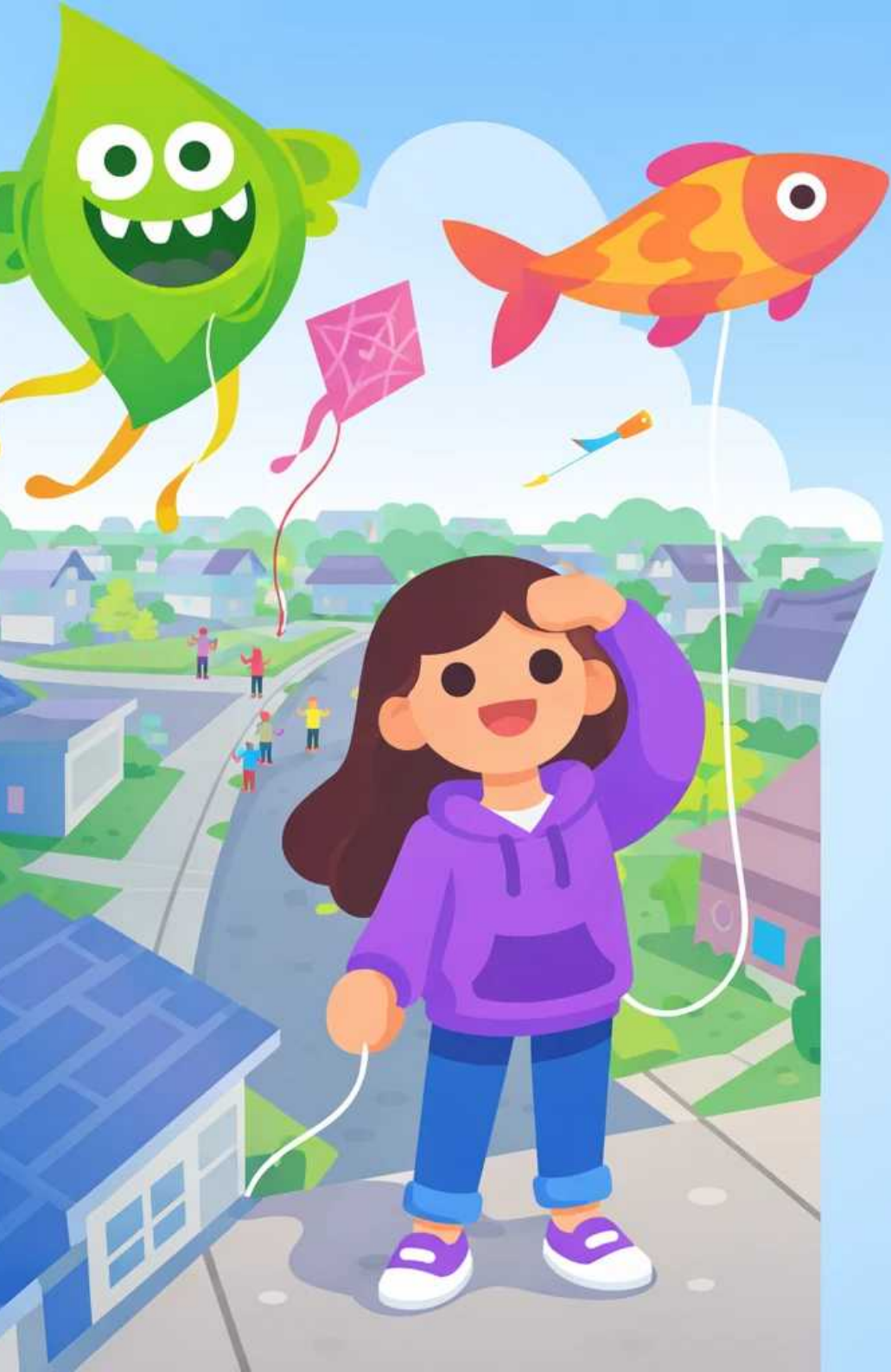


Go,

right.

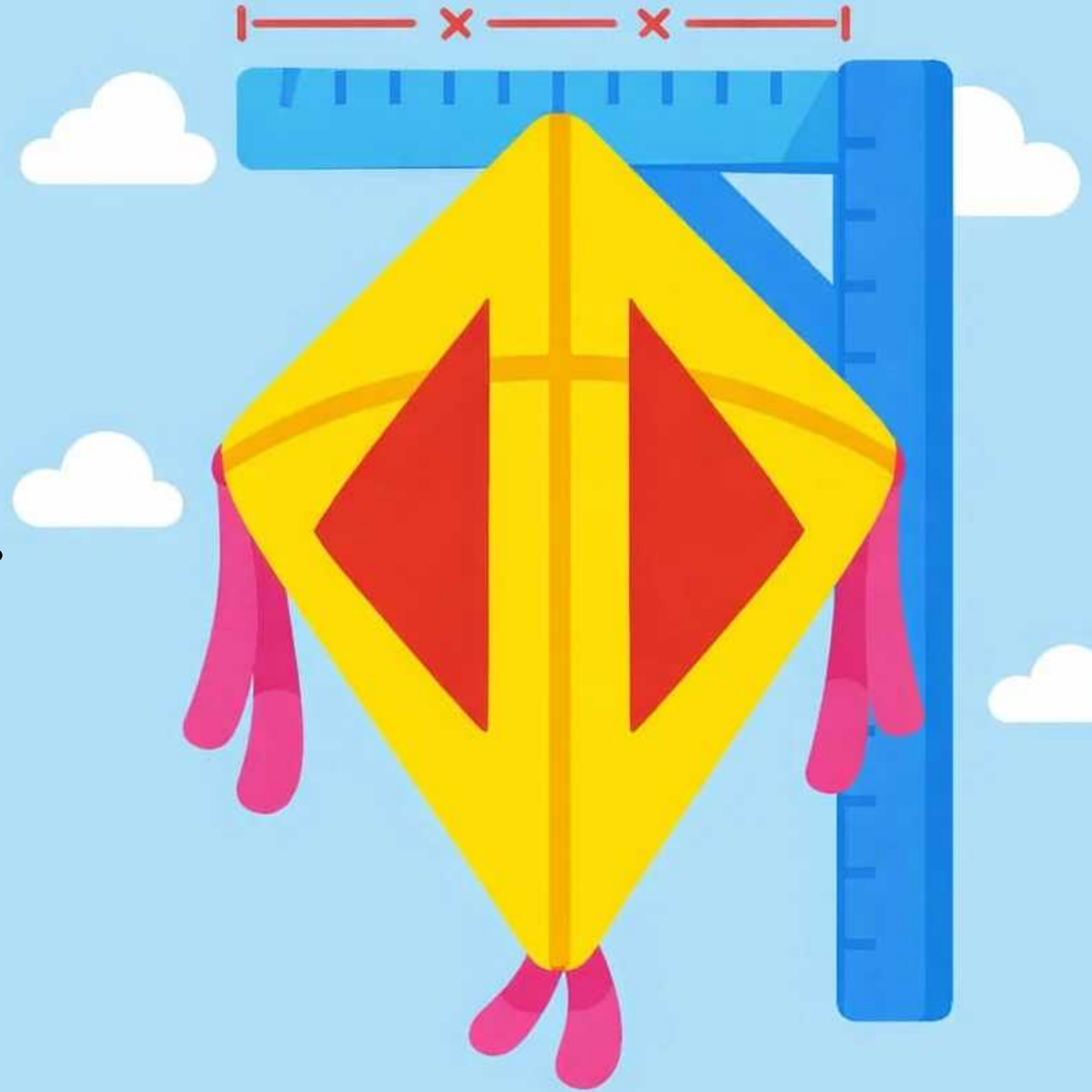




My kite is up
