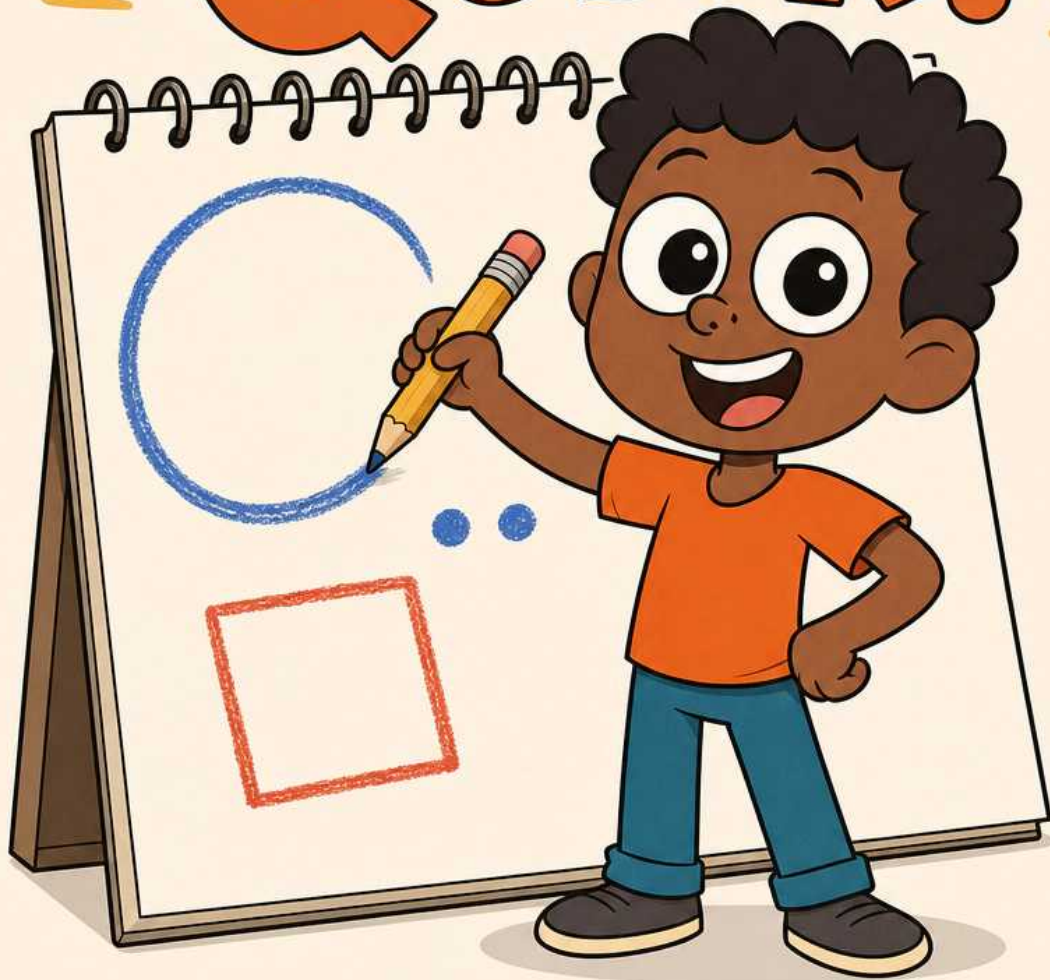


Guess It Quick!

Slick!

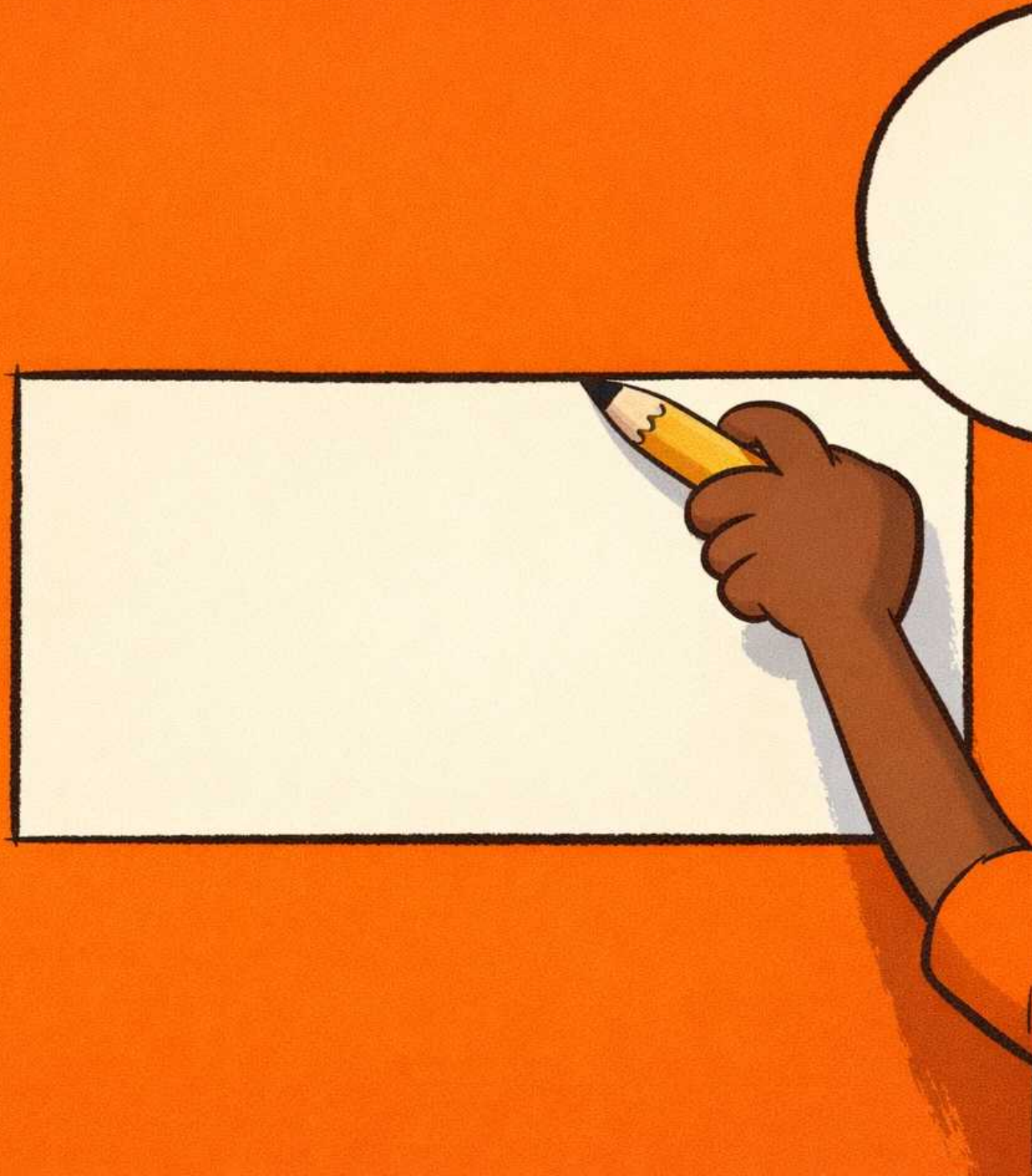
Two huge dots

long neck?

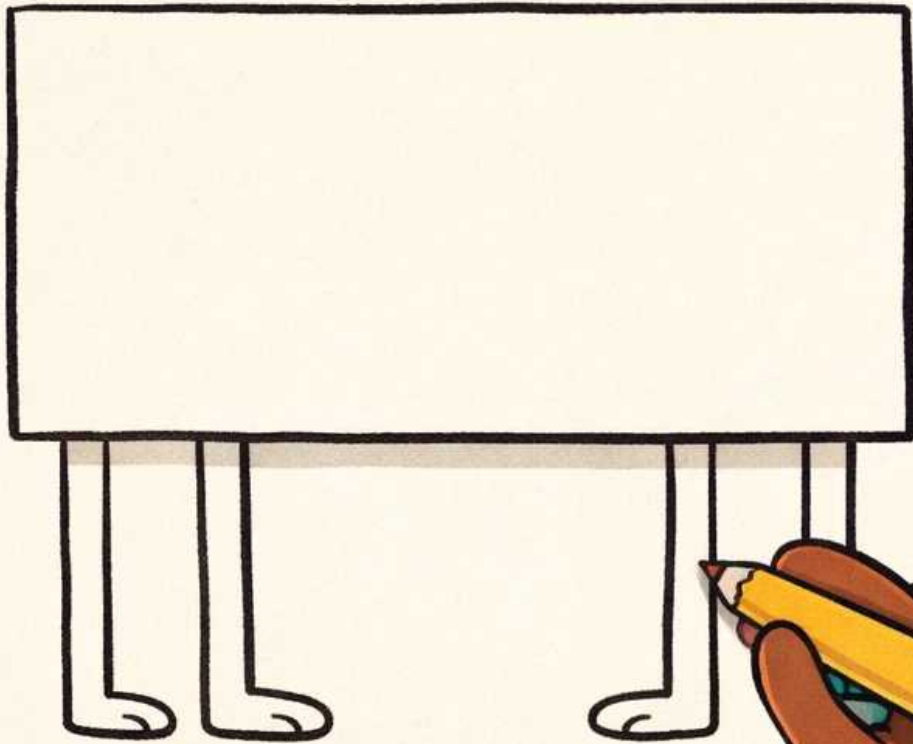




Fred shades it

and slick!'





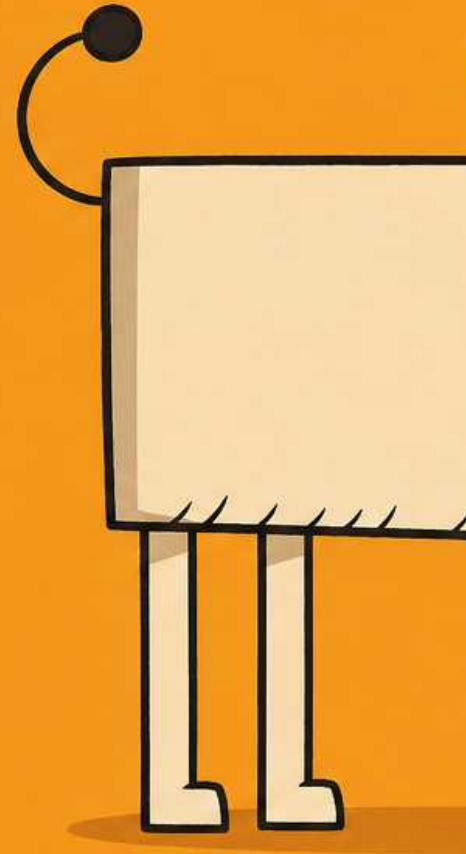
Fred lifts it up.

'Your turn,' says

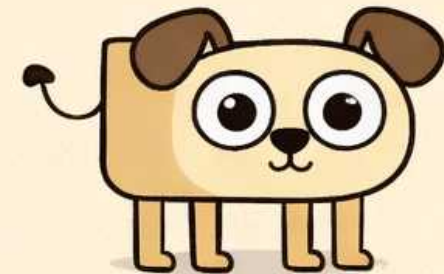
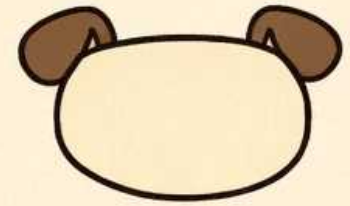
Fred. 'Be quick!

Guess It Quick!

Fred has a secret talent and a sneaky little game. He picks up his pencil, draws a circle, then another, then a big black shape - and dares you to guess what it is. Is it a frog? A duck? A drone with legs? Every time you shout an answer, Fred just grins and keeps going. Can you work out what Fred is drawing before he finishes? This decodable reader practices the 'ck' sound in words like 'quick,' 'click,' 'stack,' and 'trick.'
