'He is not here,' says Cob.



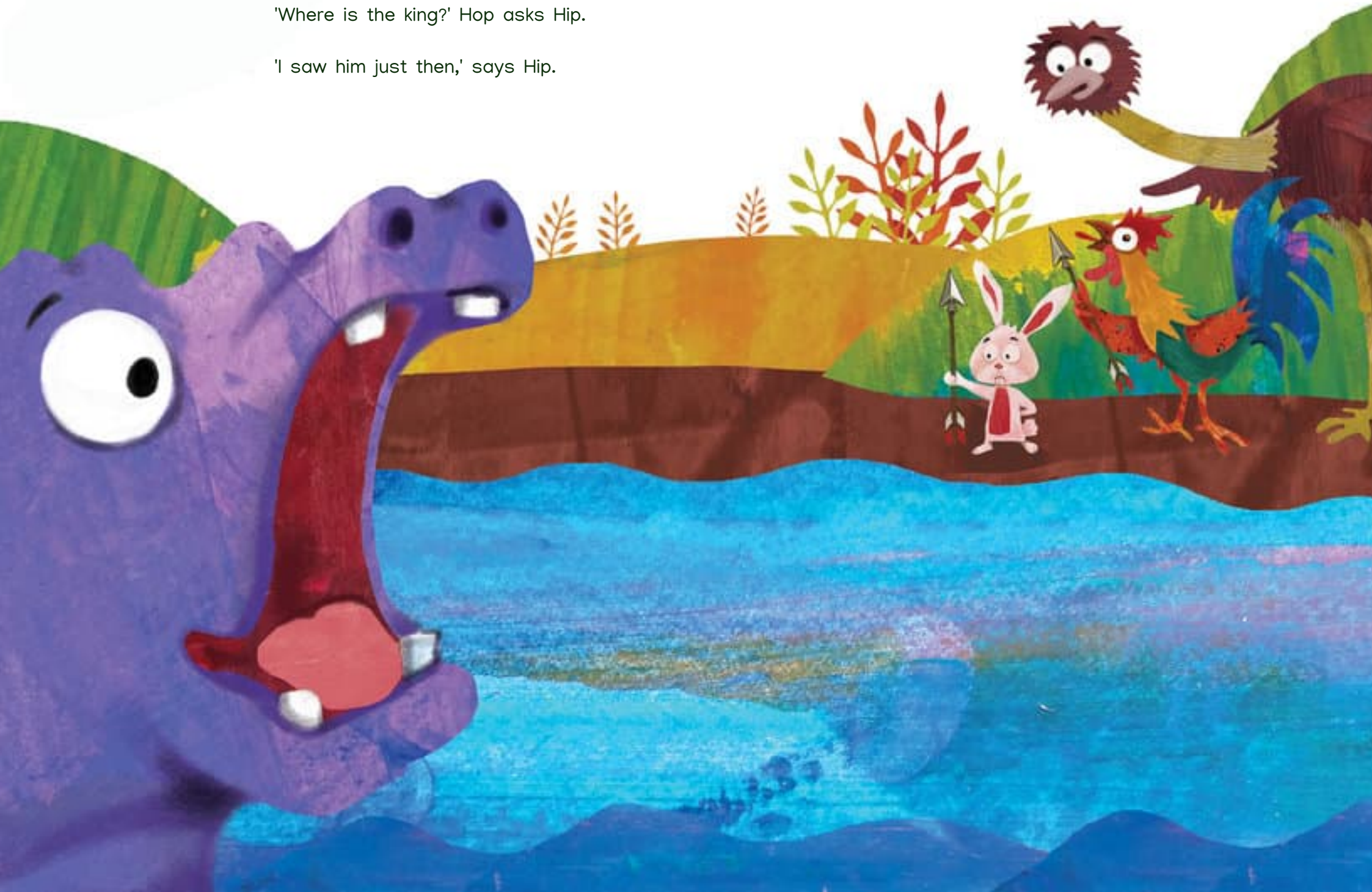
'Where is the king?' Hop asks
