

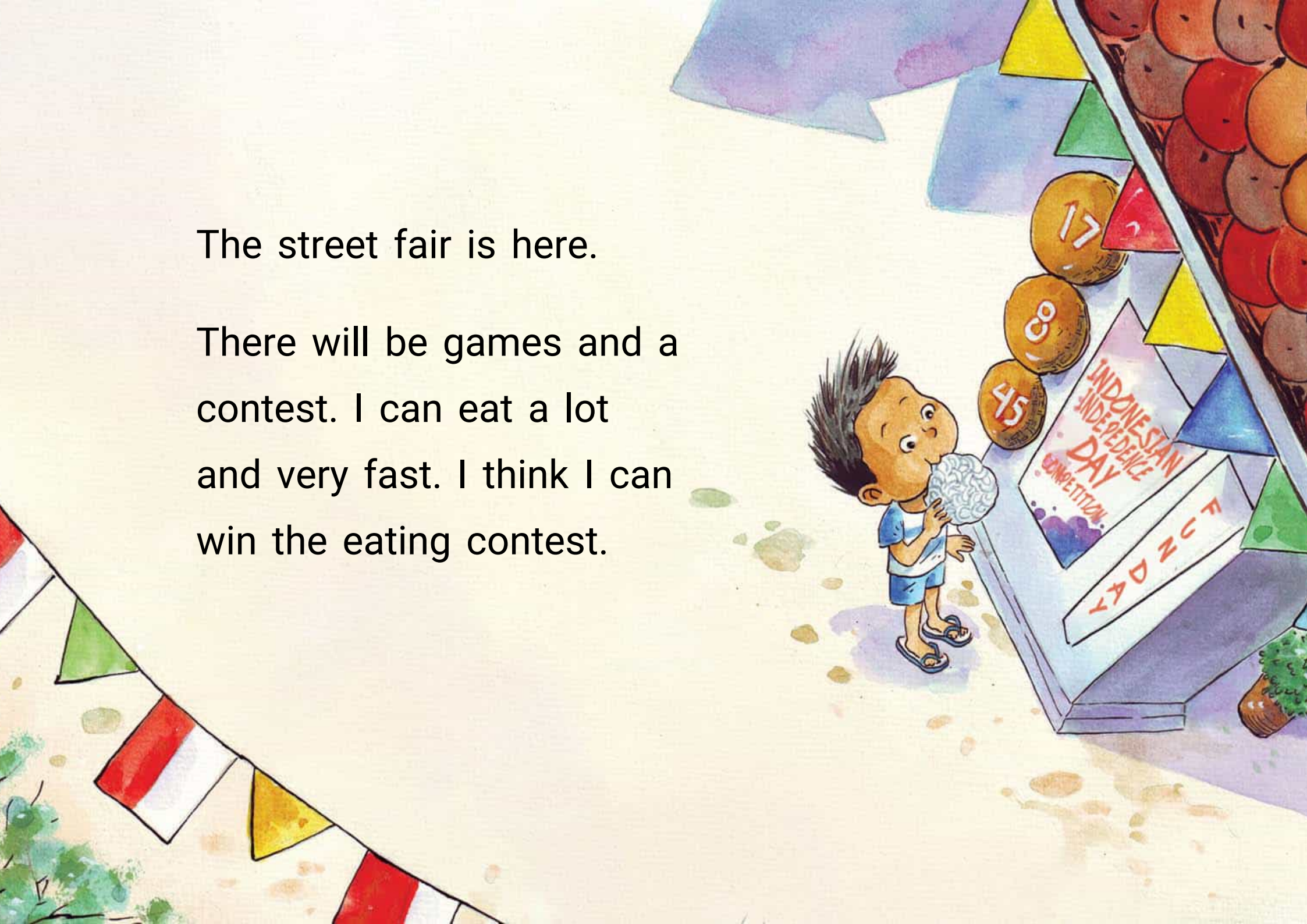
# IN MY TUM



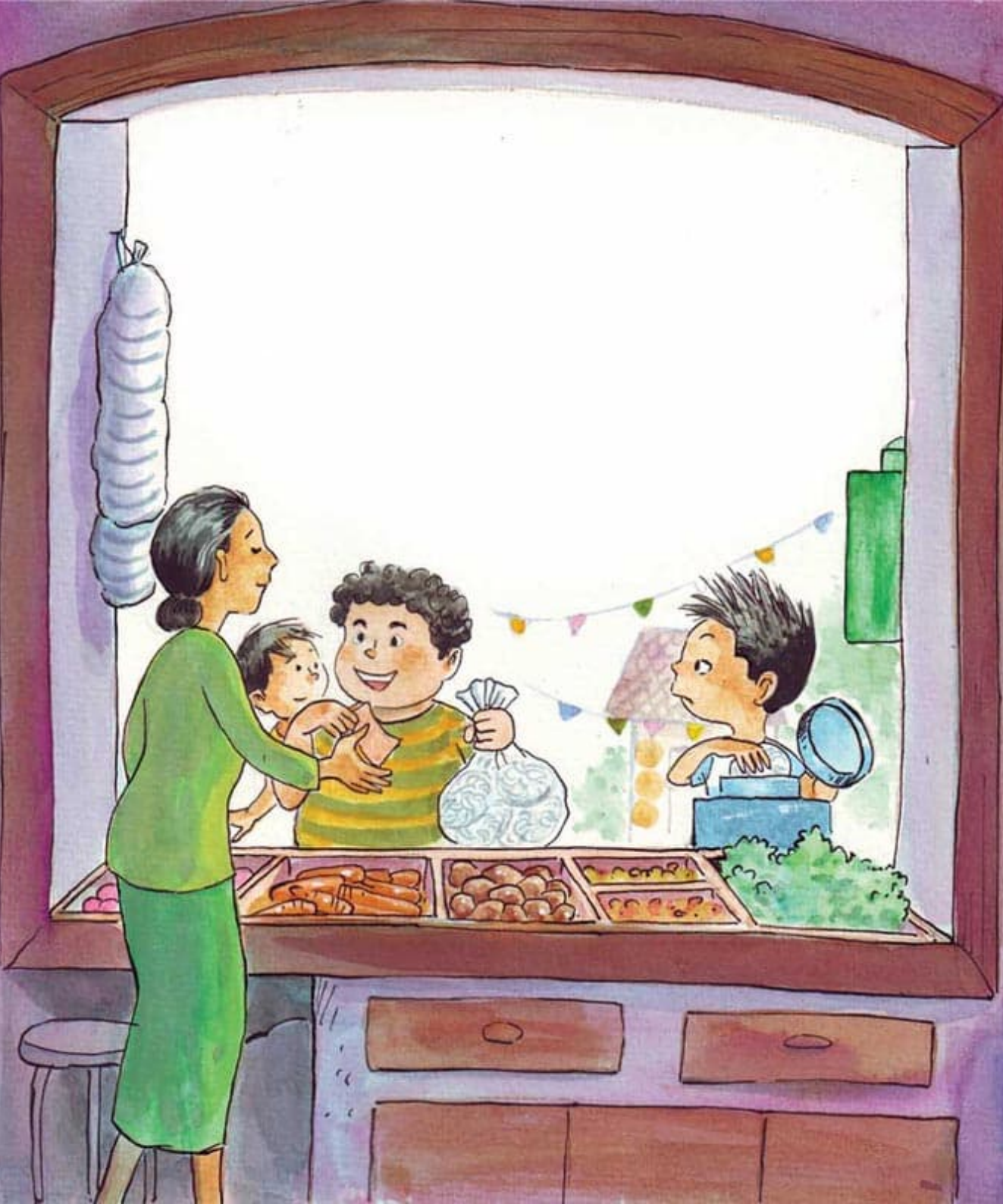

noodles to practice.

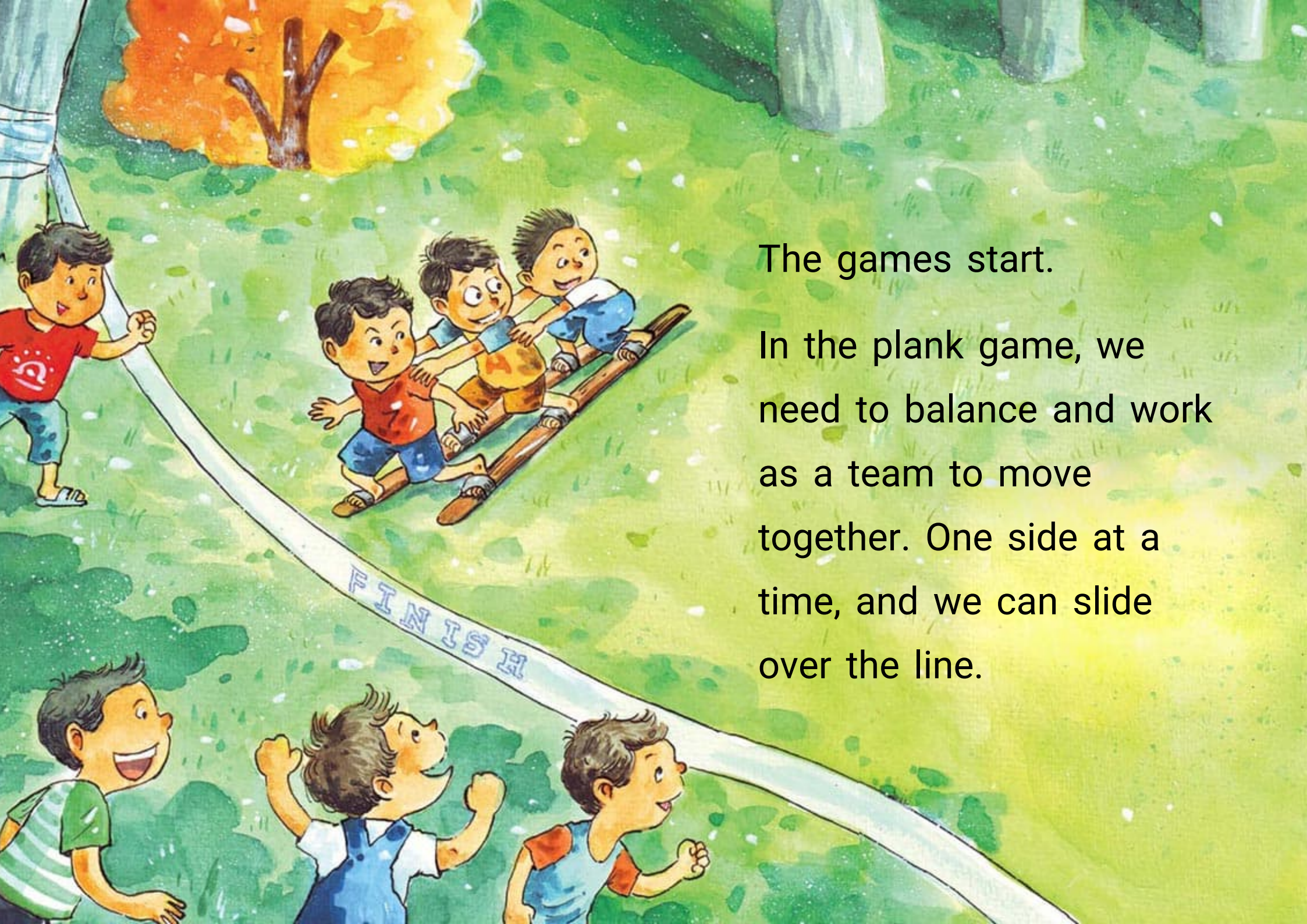


I want to win so badly that I

The next game is the balloon burst game. We put out heads together and try to make it pop. But my head is not in the game.



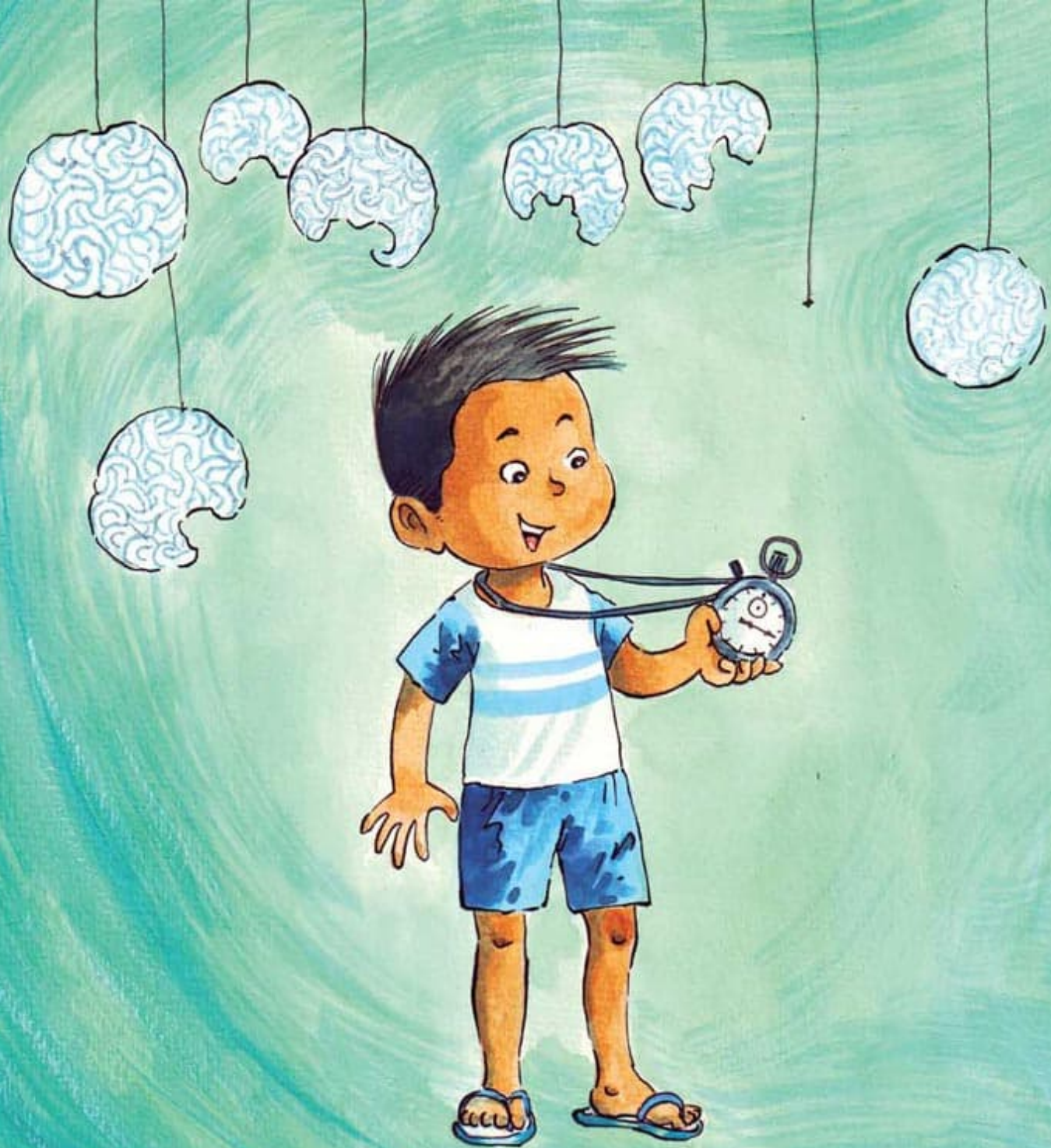

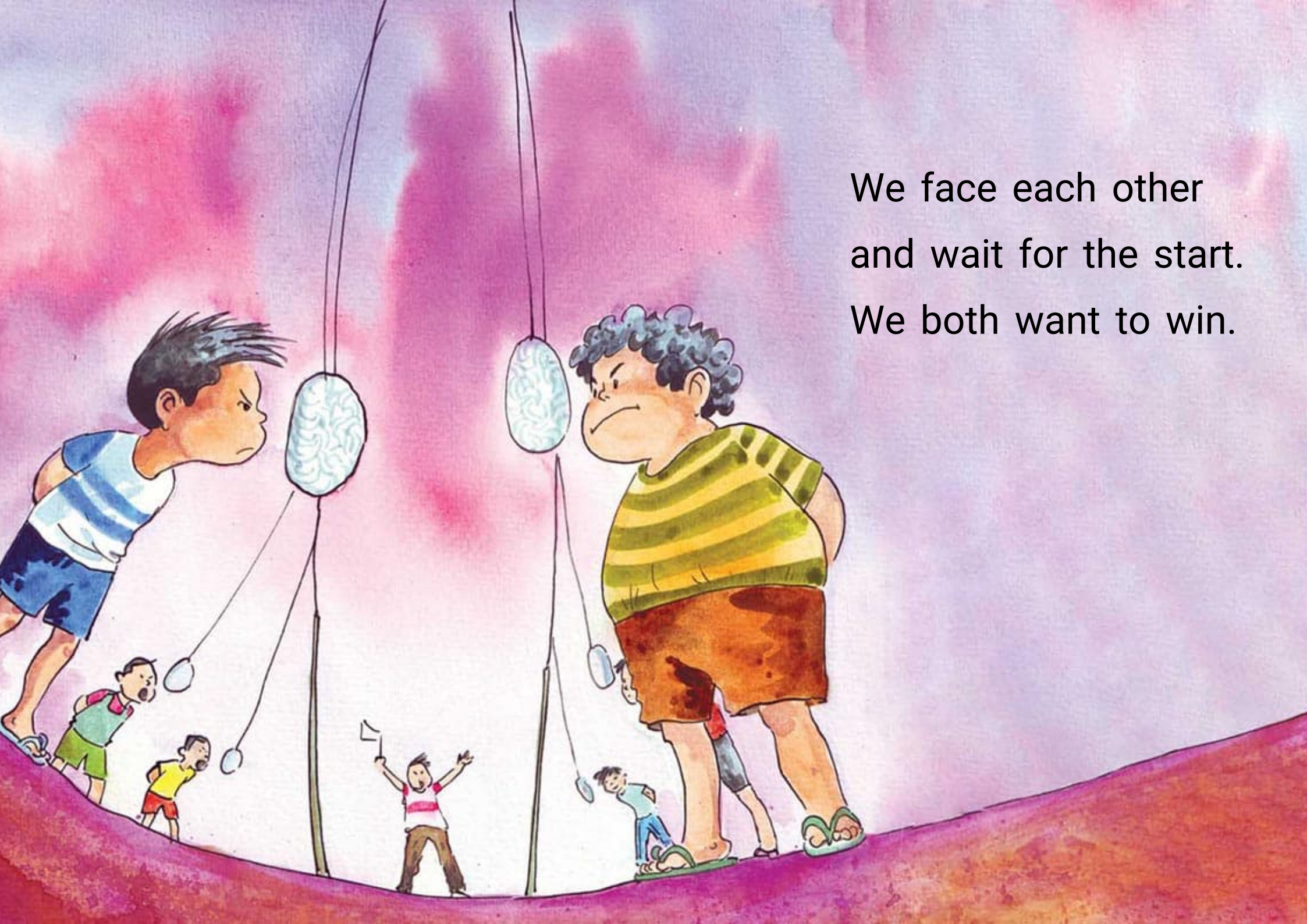


So I practice that too.

But I can't eat any more. There is no space left in my tum.

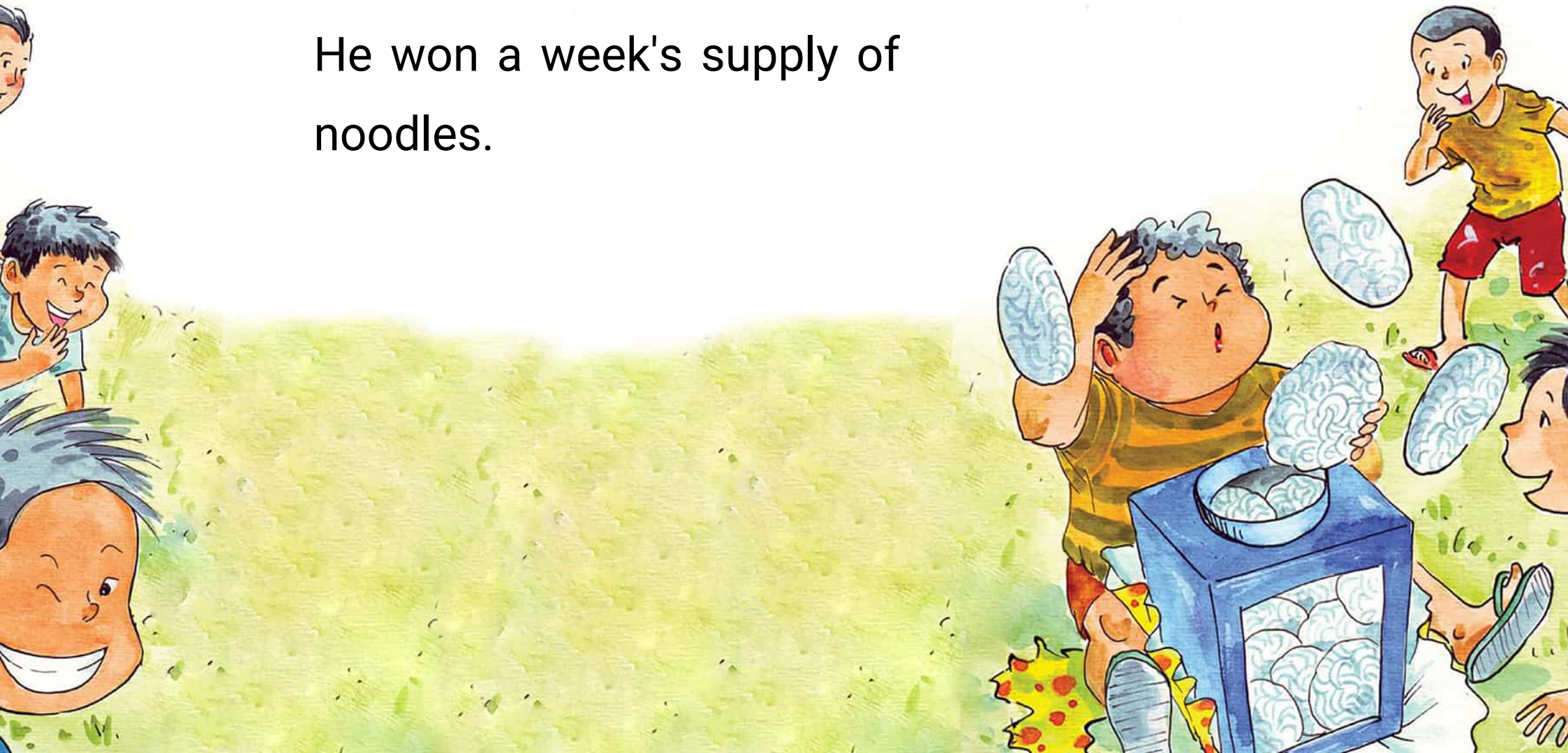




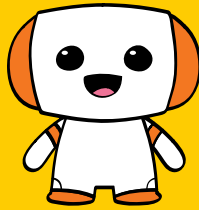
Tim is the winner!
