# JACK ATTACK

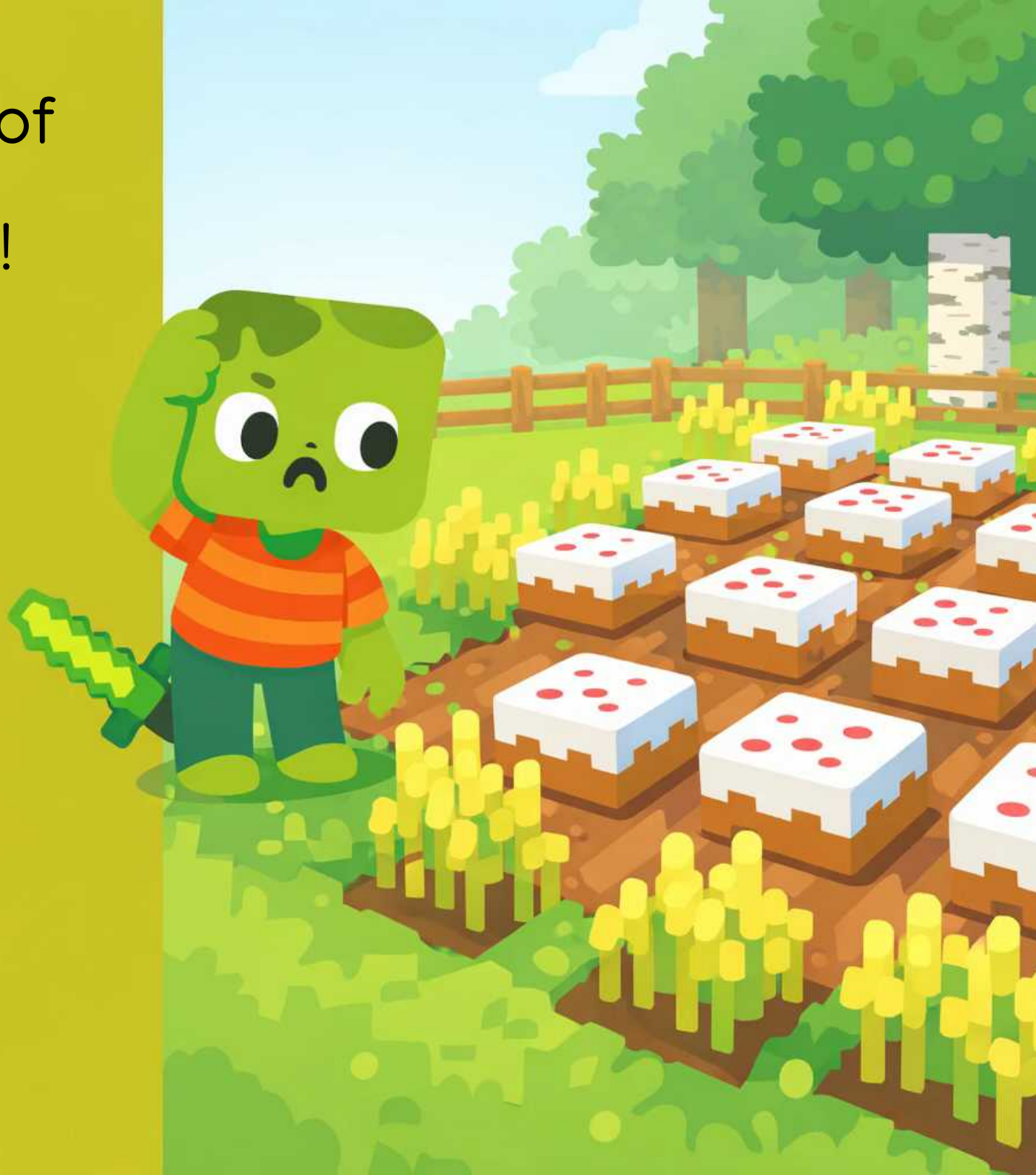




One morning, Zom stretches and heads out to start his farm chores, but he is met with a very odd sight.
