well made.

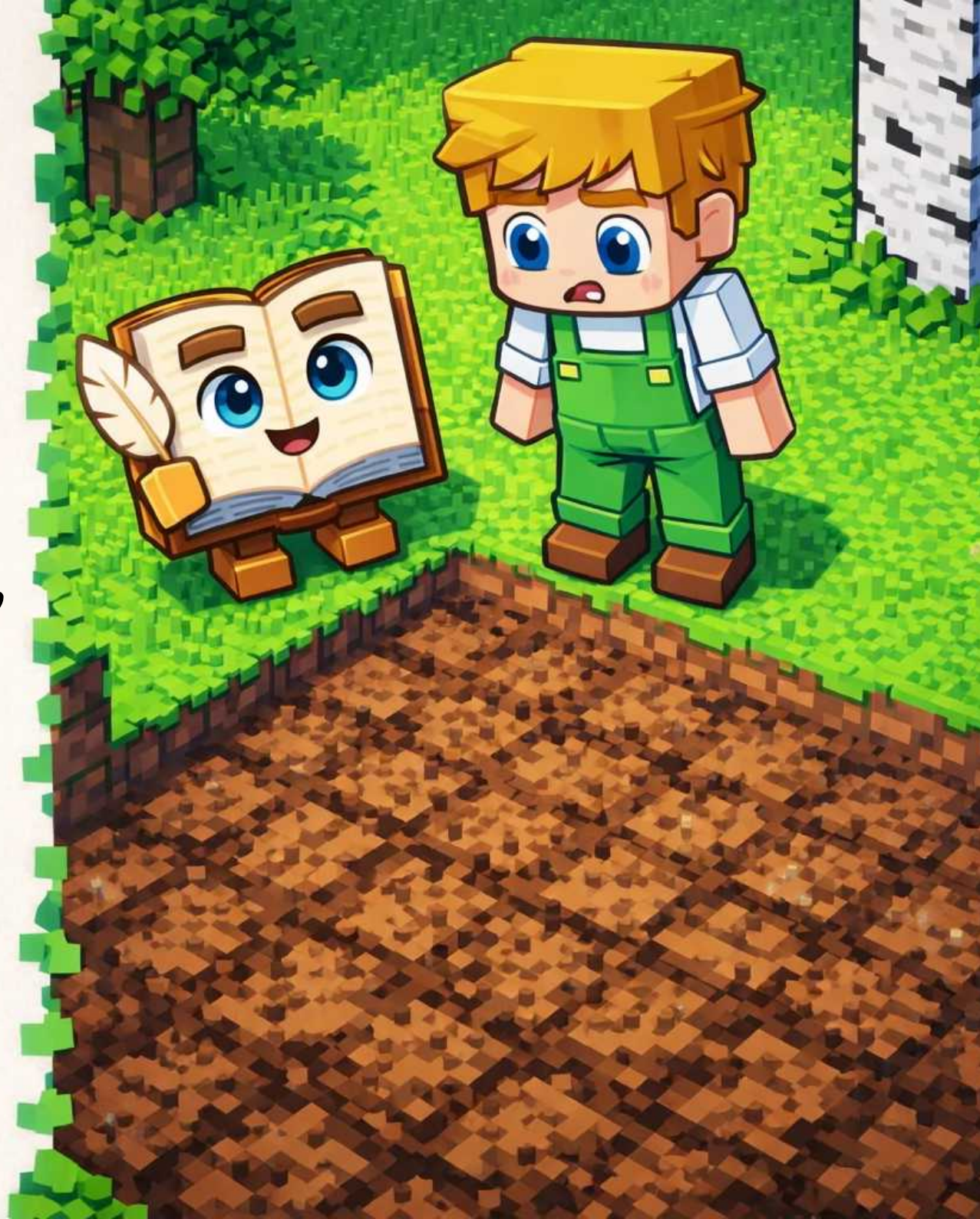




Ned cut dirt
