It takes him all morning to put contraptions in one chest and redstone in another one. **Once** he can see the floor, he needs to think about what has gone into all those chests.





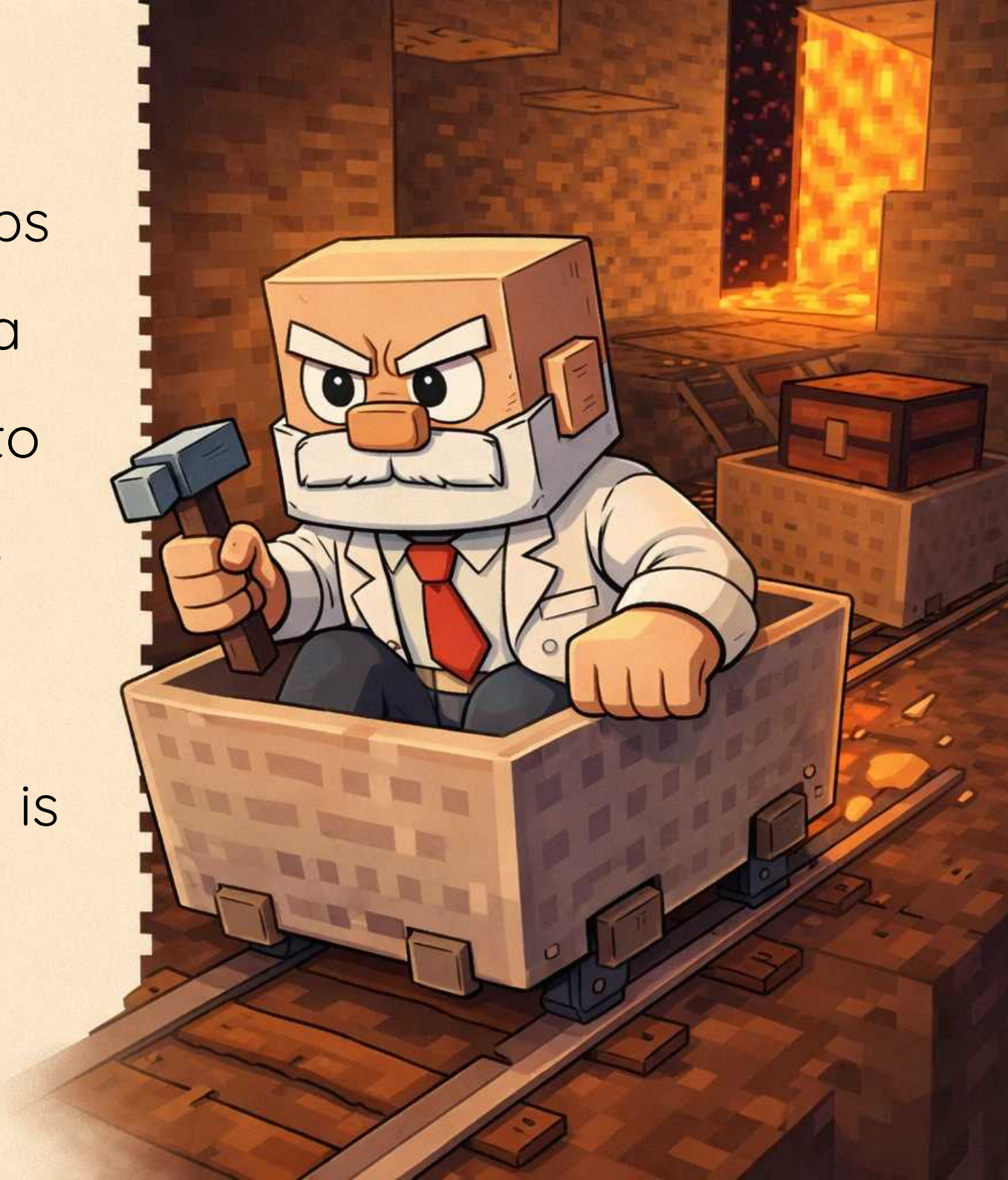
He has too much stone and deepslate. There is **excess** everywhere he looks!
