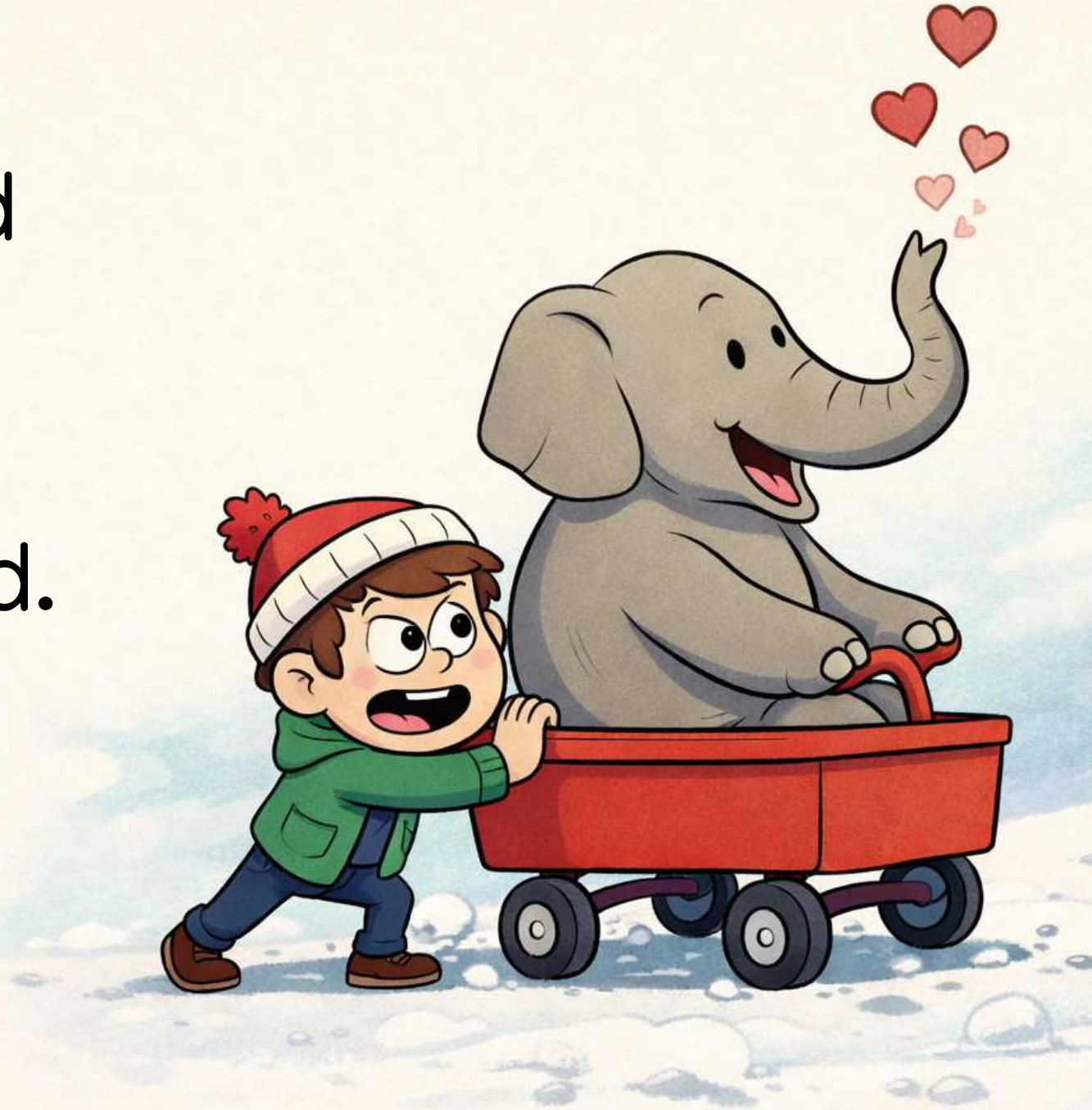


# Oh Boy, a Big Beast!

small voice.



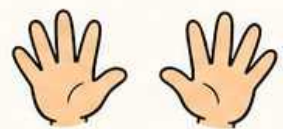
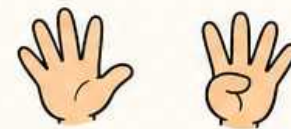
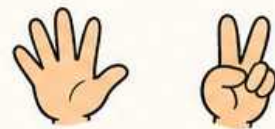
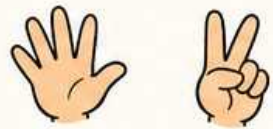


A bird stood
