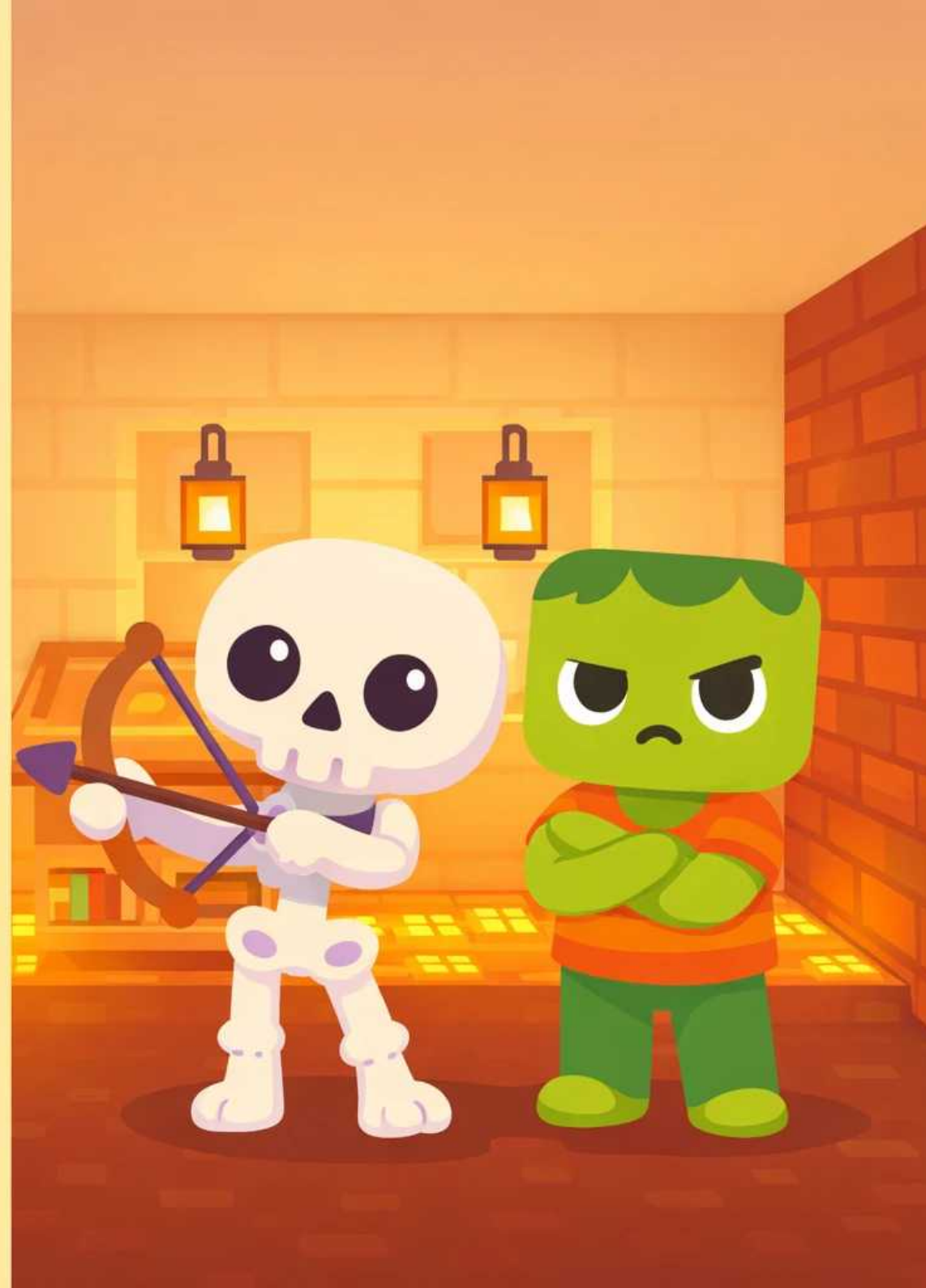


Pests!

Chores are through!

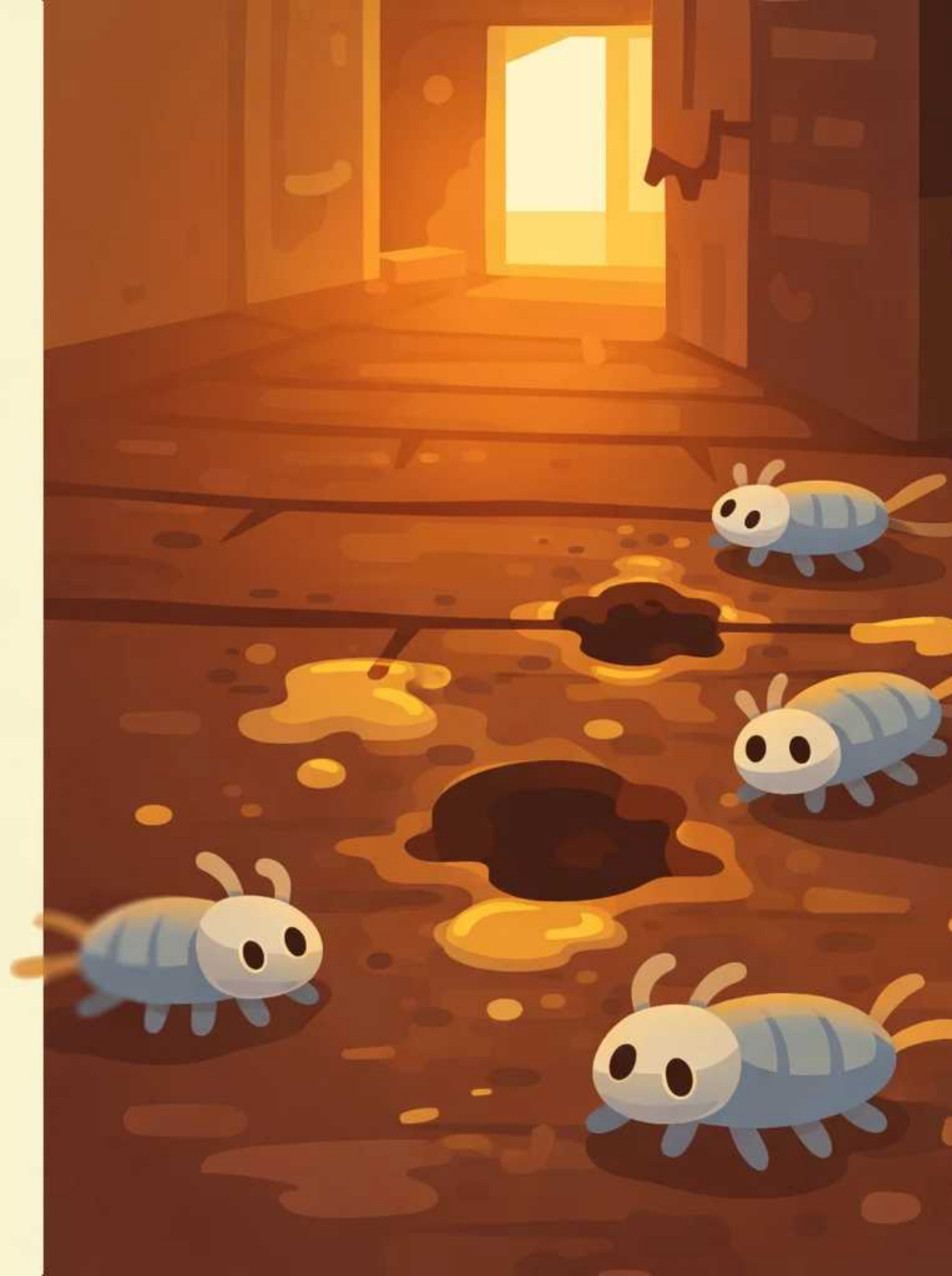
Life is sweet!
