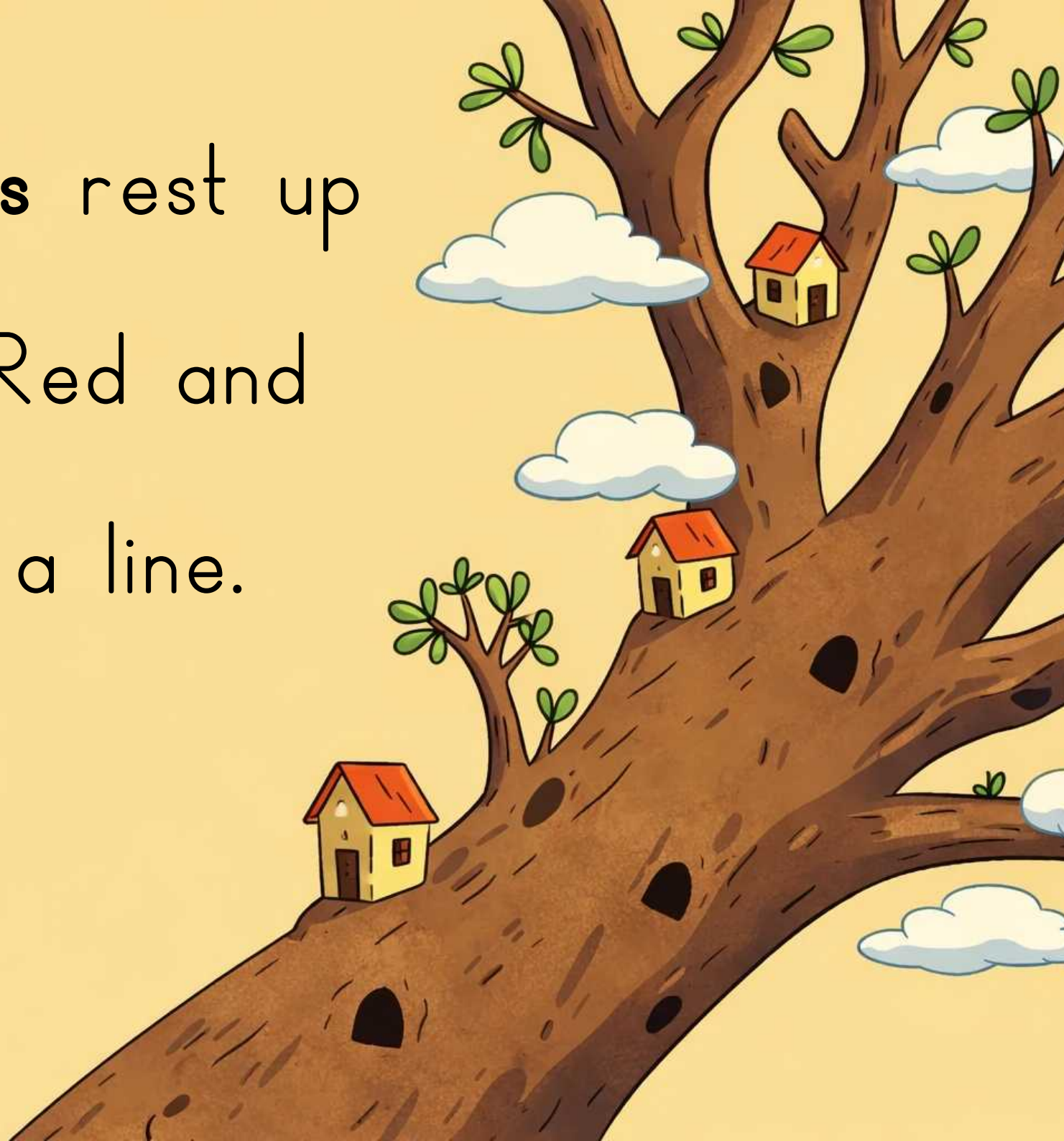


PIP AND THE LOST NUTS
