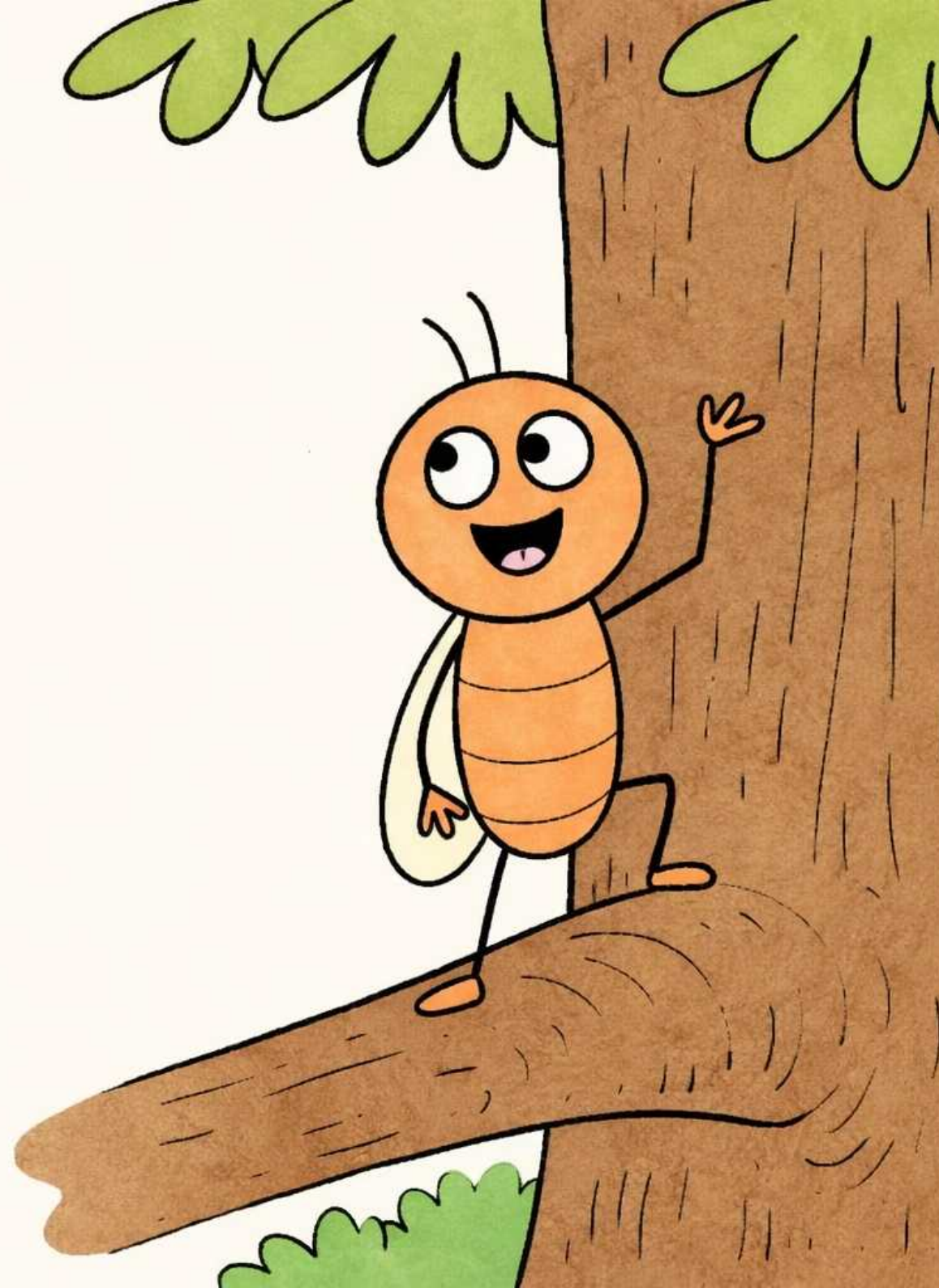


Sing It, Bug!



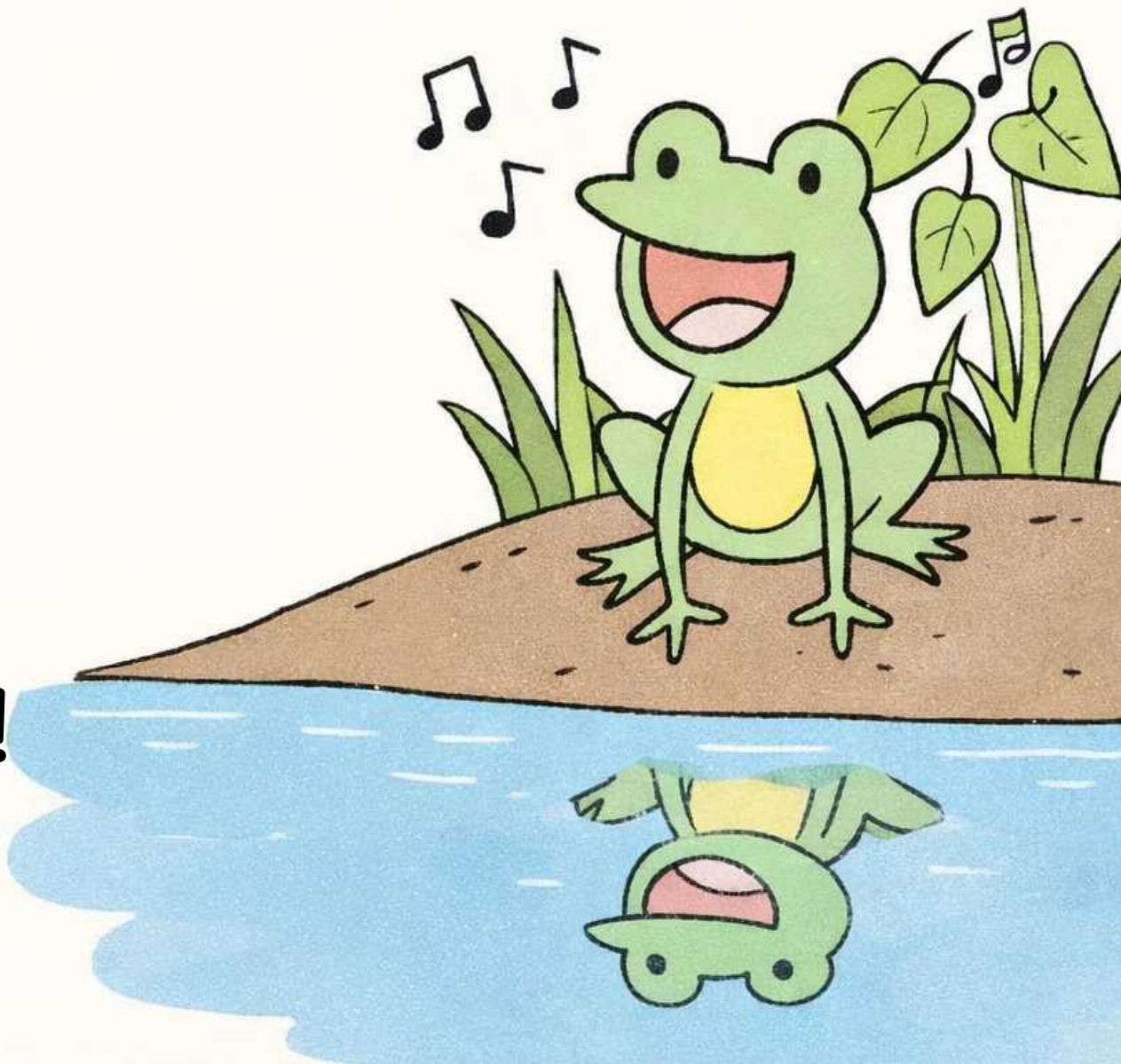
Spring has

long song.

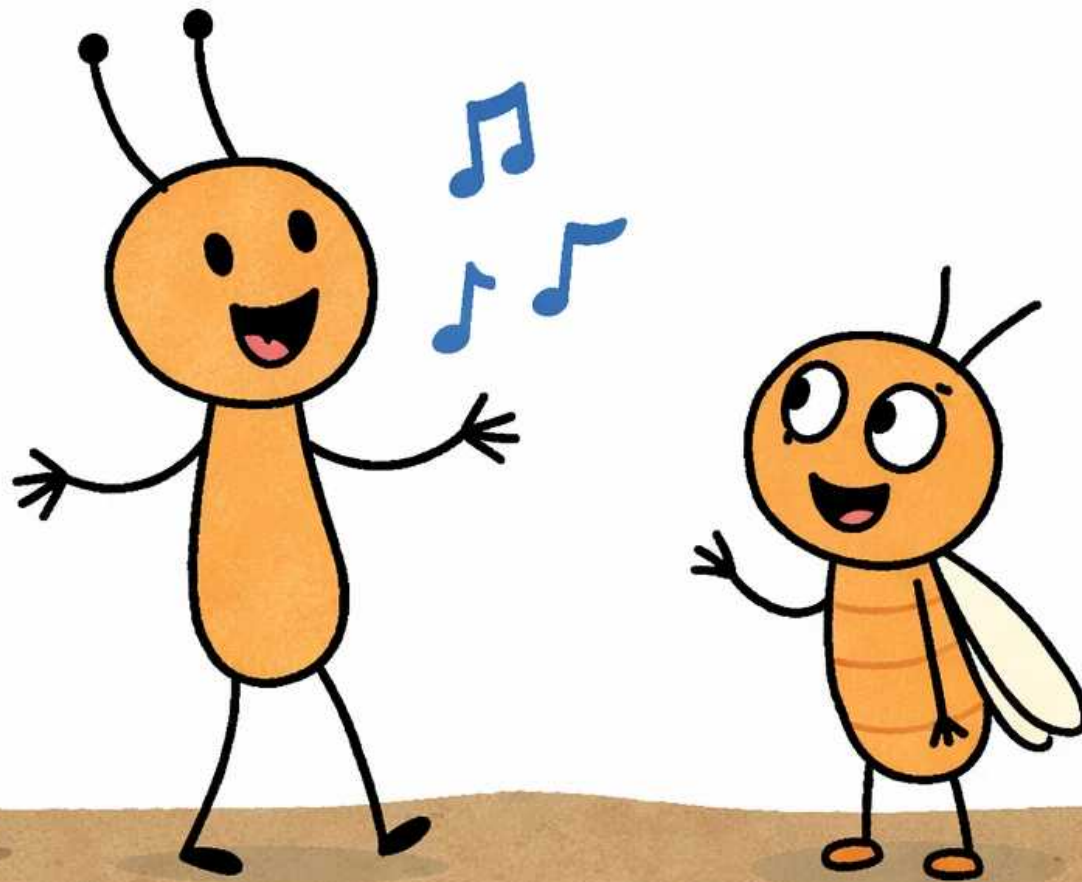
Bug likes it, but

such a fun thing!

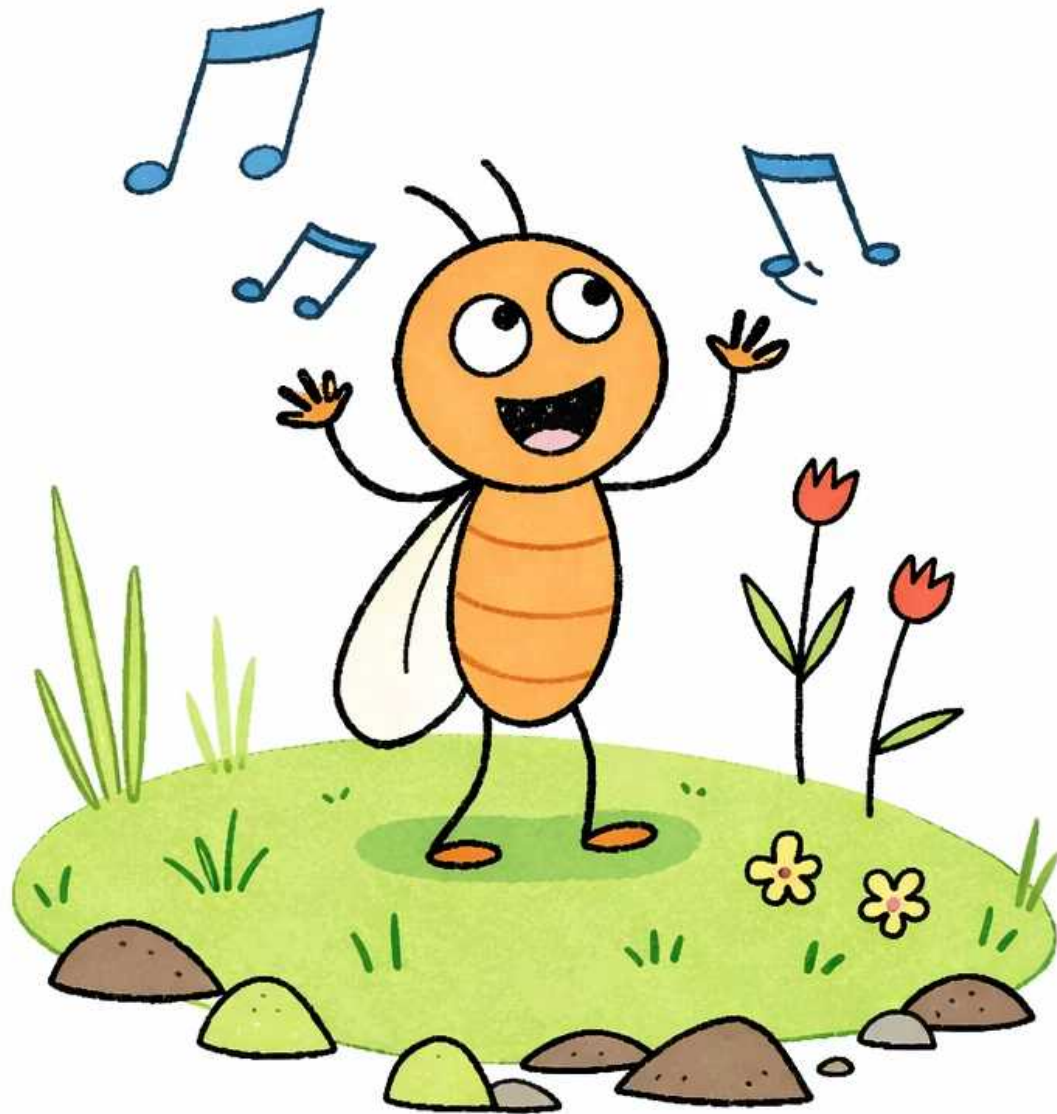


Bug wants each pal to sing
