there!

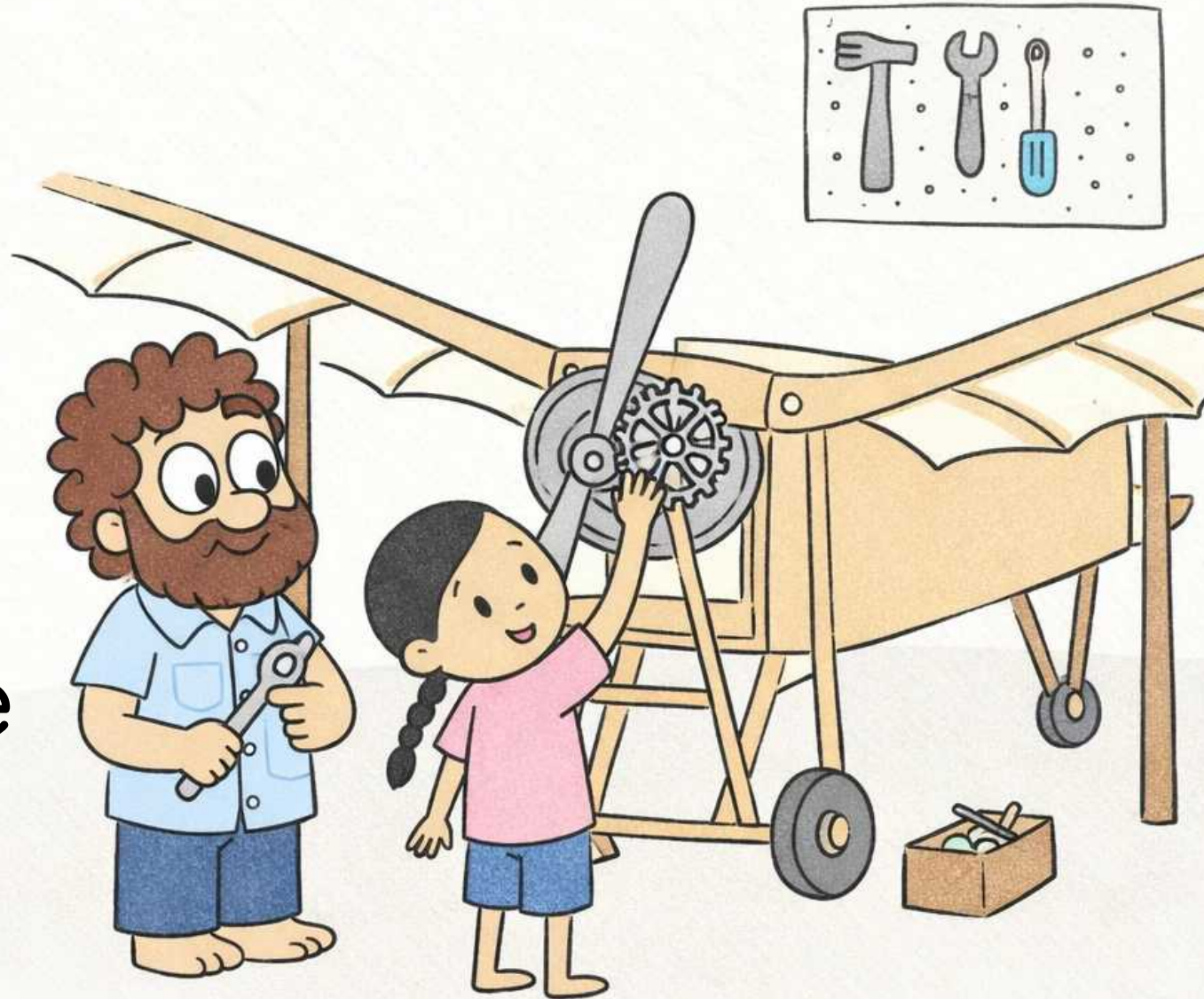
Panha grabs

she thinks.



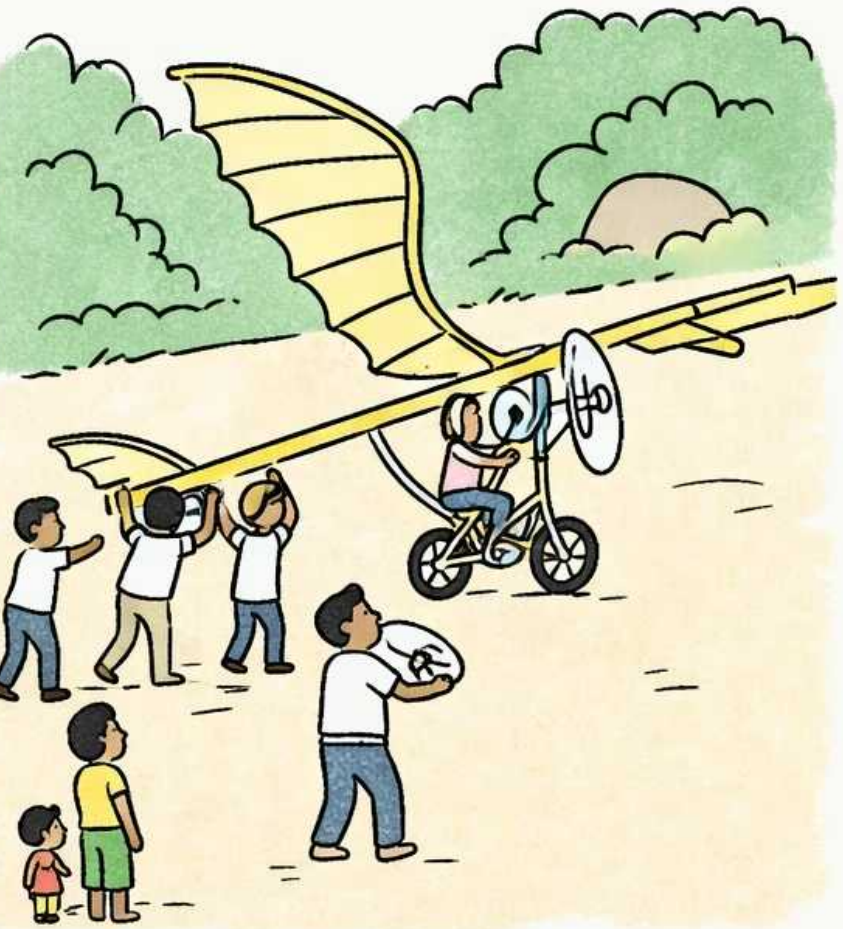


Then

and smooth.

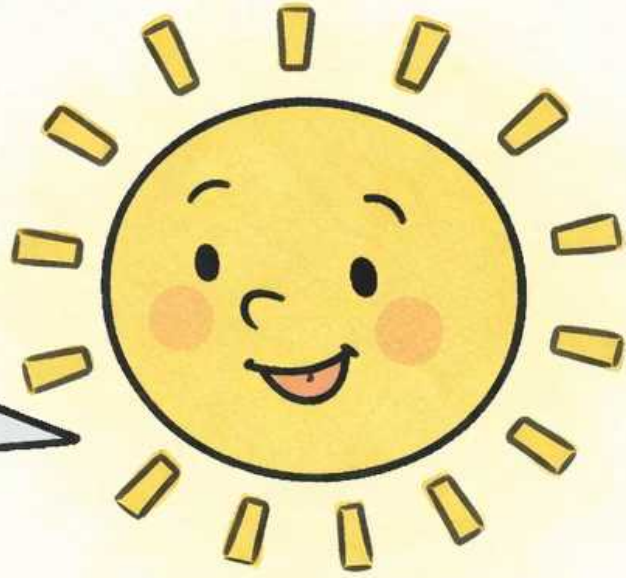
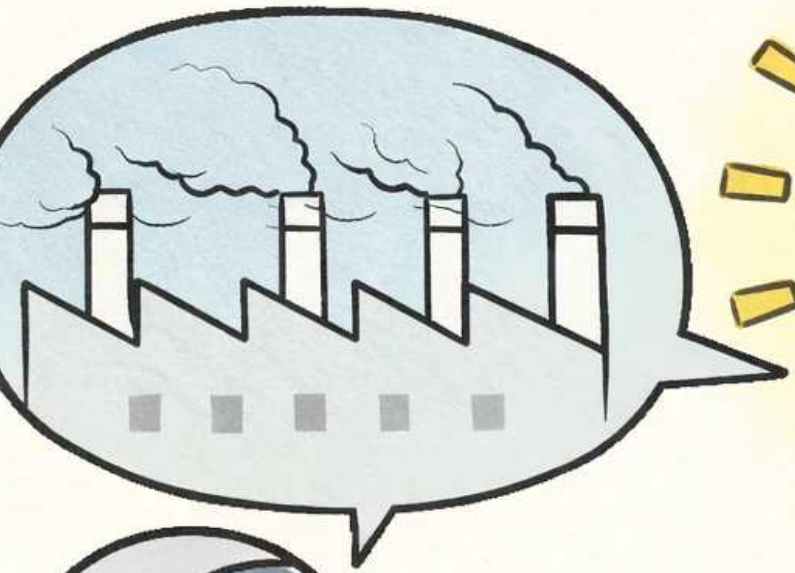


Lots of kids and men want to see Panha set off. Then Dad hands her a hat. 'Get the sun,' he tells her.

stop!

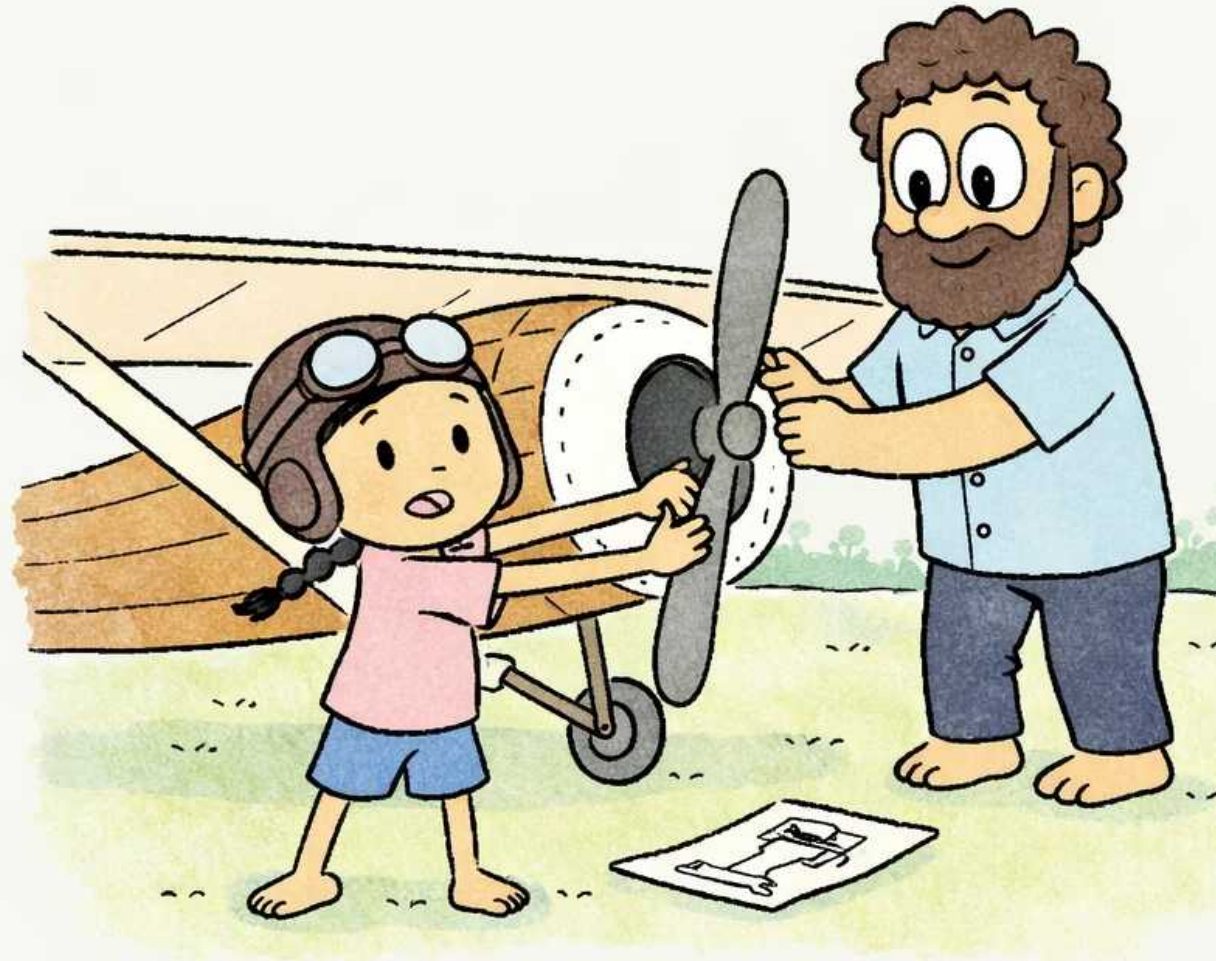




They get
