

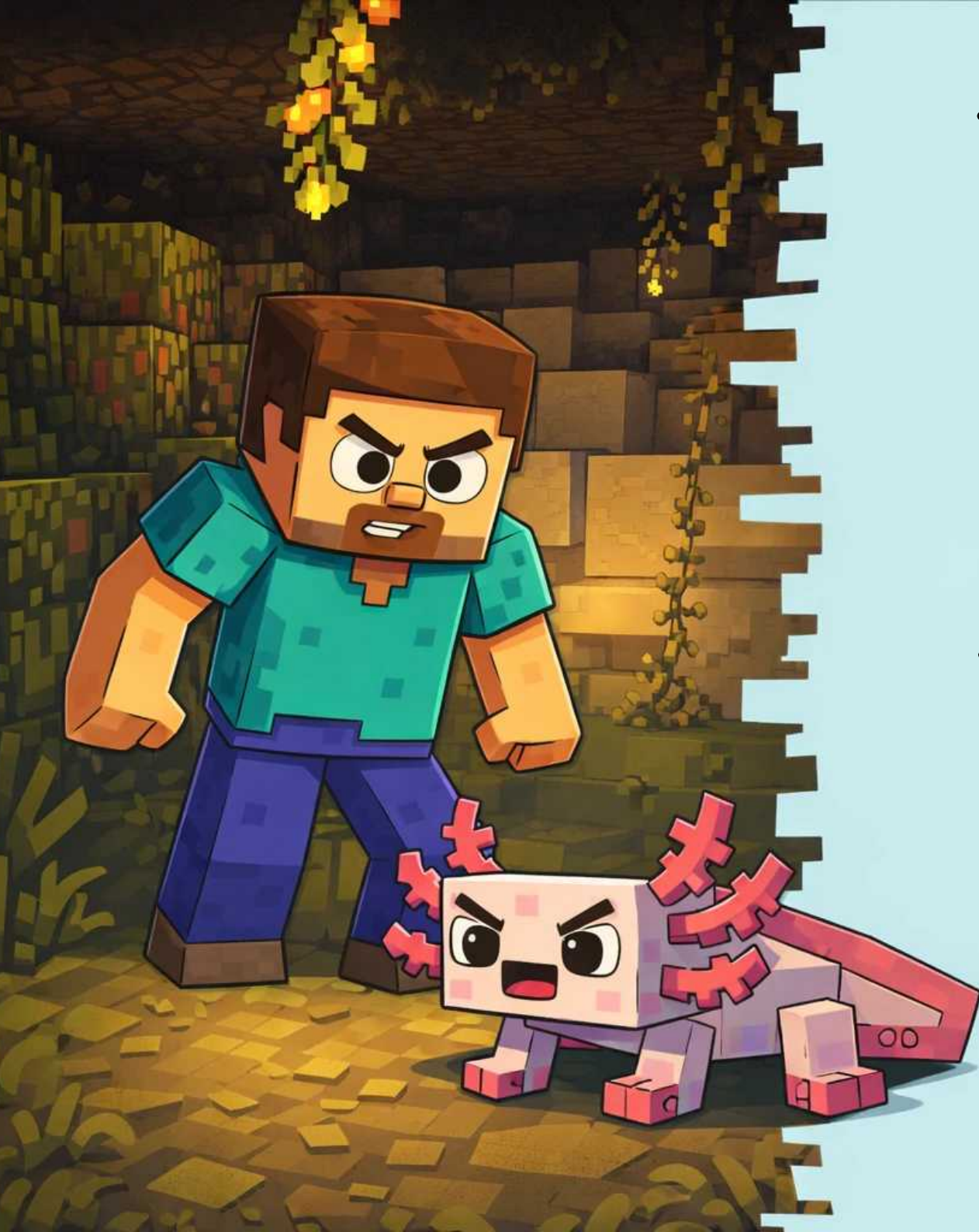
The Thing in the Cave!

Steve.

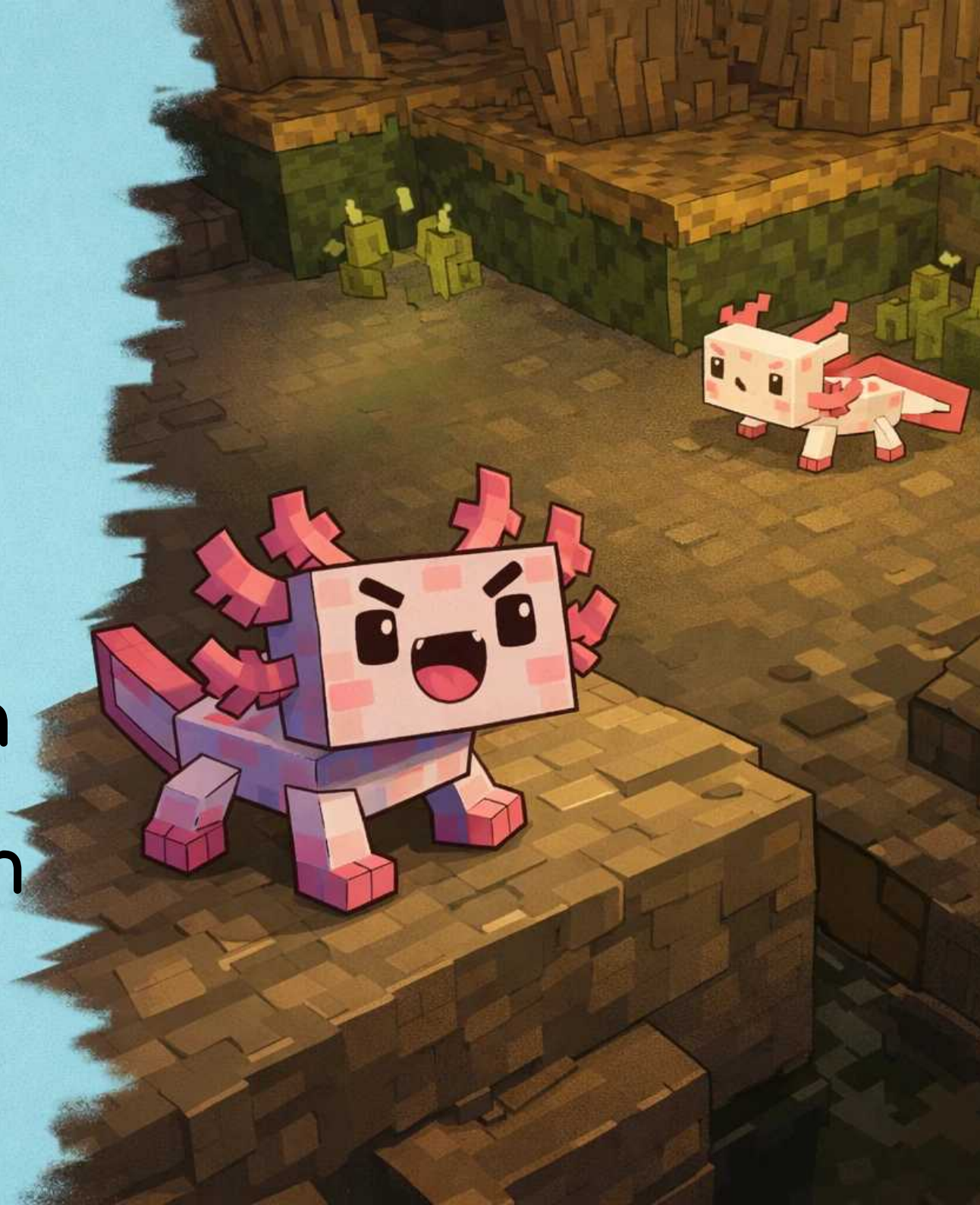
Steve held his
