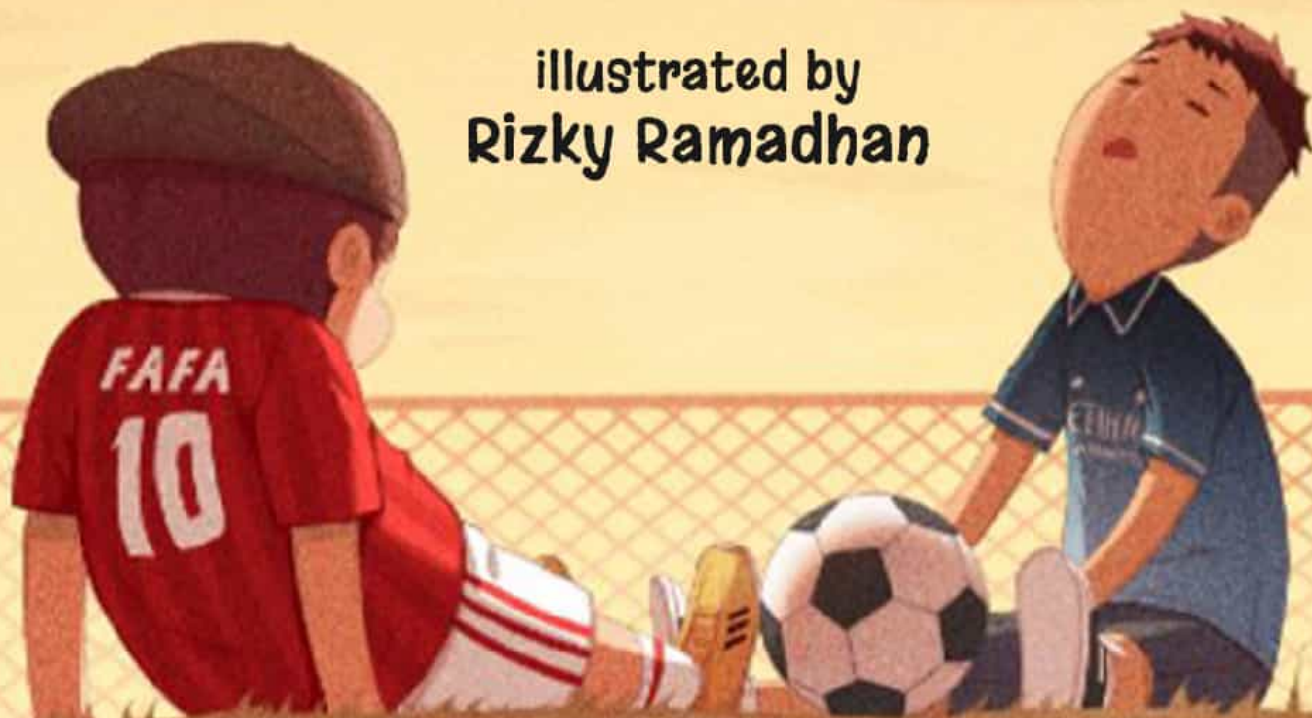


What's Your Name?
