much!

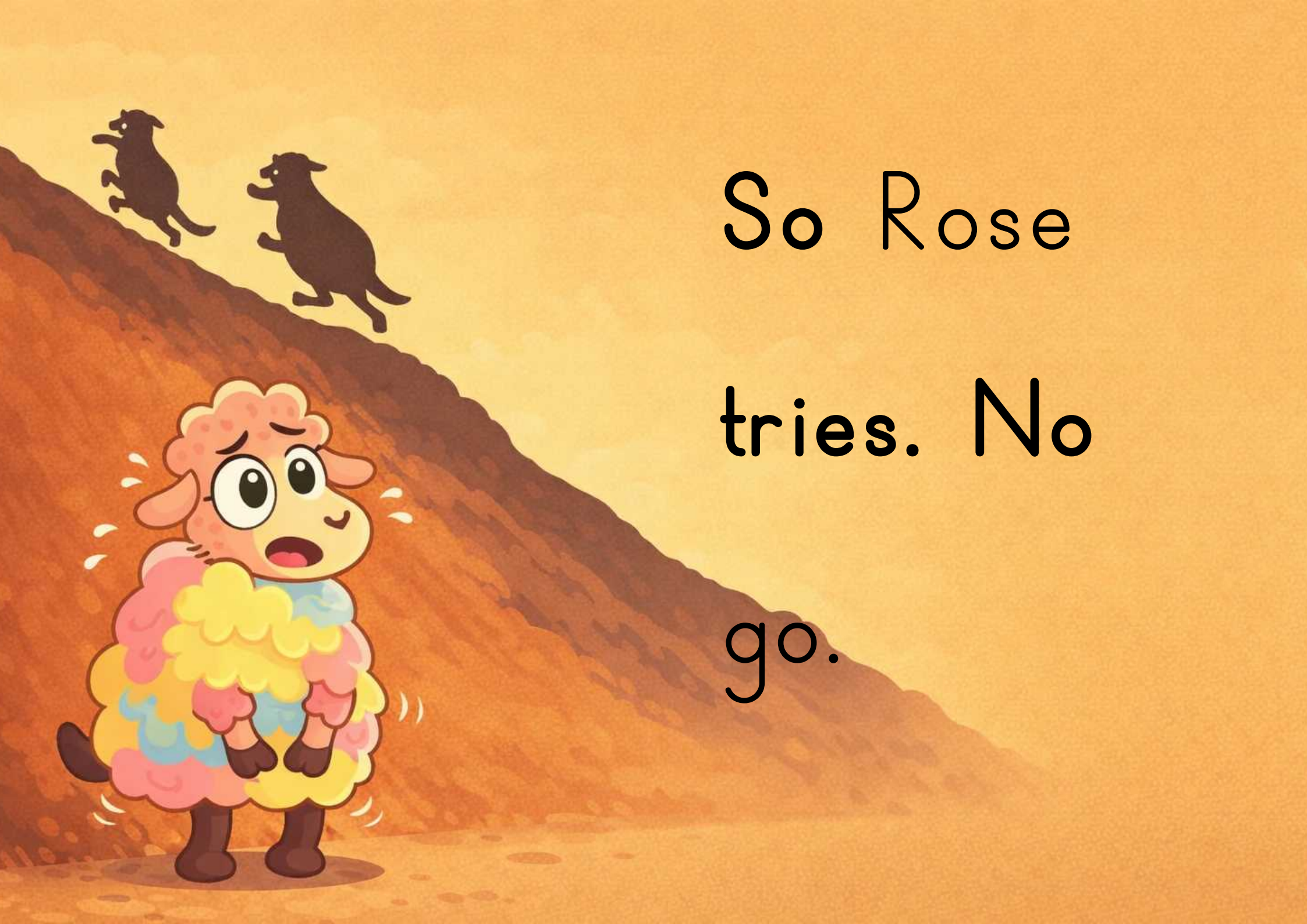


She tries. No, no. Still so
